CHAPTER 104

An Act to confer certain powers upon The City of Yorkton

(Assented to April 1, 1967)

Preamble

WHEREAS The City of Yorkton, from time to time, holds moneys to the credit of superannuation and benefit plans or funds under bylaws passed pursuant to the authority contained in section 300 of *The City Act*; and

Whereas the investment of such moneys is now limited by subsection (4) of section 300 of *The City Act*; and

Whereas The City of Yorkton wishes to invest such moneys in any form of investment open to insurance companies under the provisions of the *Canadian and British Insurance Companies Act* (Canada), and any amendments thereto, or in any investment trust funds limited to such investments; and

Whereas The City of Yorkton has presented a petition to the Legislature of the Province of Saskatchewan praying for the extension of its powers with respect to the investment of such moneys; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Extended investment power

1 Notwithstanding the limitations contained in *The City Act*, The City of Yorkton is hereby authorized and empowered from time to time to invest any moneys held by it for superannuation or benefit purposes in any investments open to insurance companies under the provisions of the *Canadian and British Insurance Companies Act* (Canada), as the same may from time to time be amended, or any Act which may be substituted, or in any mutual or investment trust fund which invests only in securities or investments which would be open to insurance companies under the said *Canadian and British Insurance Companies Act* (Canada).

Changing investments

2 The City of Yorkton is hereby authorized and empowered to sell, assign or transfer any such investments from time to time, and to invest the proceeds thereof in like investments.
