An Act respecting the Disclosure of Information by certain Saskatchewan Crown Corporations

(Assented to _____, 1998)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Crown Corporations Disclosure Act, 1998*.

Tabling of Report

2(1) Every Saskatchewan Crown corporation to which *The Crown Corporations Act, 1993* applies shall, at the sitting of the Legislative Assembly next following the expiry of ninety days from the fiscal year-end of that Crown corporation, cause the tabling of a report by the member of the Executive Council responsible for that Crown corporation to the Assembly identifying every person or corporation that received money or gratuitous services from that Crown corporation, together with the amount of money or value of service so received.

(2) The Provincial Auditor shall, in accordance with his or her duties and powers to examine all accounts related to public money and any accounts not related to public money that he or she is required by an Act to examine as set out in *The Provincial Auditor Act*, examine and report upon those transactions enumerated in the report referred to in subsection (1).

Report of losses of Crown corporation

3 Every Saskatchewan Crown corporation to which *The Crown Corporations Act, 1993* applies shall, within sixty days of incurring any financial loss of \$100,000 or more in any one transaction, report such loss to the Standing Committee on Crown Corporations of the Saskatchewan Legislative Assembly.

Coming into force

4 This Act comes into force on assent.
