A BYLAW RESPECTING PUBLIC PARKS  
UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MEEWASIN  
VALLEY AUTHORITY AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY  
OF CORMAN PARK, NO. 344

#### **Short Title**

1 This bylaw may be cited as the *Public Parks Bylaw*.

#### INTERPRETATION

2 In the bylaw:

- (a) “**Authority**” means the Meewasin Valley Authority;
- (b) “**Chief Enforcement Officer**” means the Chief Enforcement Officer of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 Police Department;
- (c) “**City**” means the City of Saskatoon;
- (d) “**Conservation Officer**” means a person appointed by the Authority whose duties include the administration of bylaws enacted by the Authority for the protection of public parks and their safe use by members of the public;
- (e) “**Director**” means the Chief Executive Officer of the Authority;
- (f) “**Firearm**” means any device from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, includes a rifle, shotgun, pellet gun, air gun, pistol, revolver, spring gun, longbow or crossbow;
- (g) “**Participating Party**” means the Government of Saskatchewan, the University of Saskatchewan or the City;
- (h) “**Police Officer**” means a member of the Police Department of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park, a member of the Police Department of the City of Saskatoon or a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police;
- (i) “**Program Leader**” means a person designated by the Director to conduct environmental education programs in the public parks;
- (j) “**Public Park**” means those lands owned by the Authority or by a participating party within the jurisdiction of the Authority to which this bylaw applies pursuant to Sections 4, 5, and 6;
- (k) “**Vehicle**” means a vehicle as defined by *The Vehicle Administration Act* of Saskatchewan.

- (f) Poplar Bluffs Conservation Area;
- (g) Wanuskewin Heritage Park;

as those lands are described in Schedule A of this bylaw.

5(a) Pursuant to the procedure stipulated in subsection 5(b), the application of this bylaw may be extended to other land owned by the Authority, or by a participating party by designating that land to be a public park subject to the provisions of this bylaw;

(b) where the land to be designated a public park subject to the provisions of this bylaw is owned by:

(i) the Authority, the Authority shall pass a resolution designating the land as a public park subject to the provisions of this bylaw;

(ii) a participating party, the participating party shall send to the Authority a written request that the land be designated a public park subject to the provisions of this bylaw and the Authority may pass a resolution designating that land to be a public park subject to the provisions of this bylaw.

6 Where the procedure stipulated in Section 5 for the extension of the application of this bylaw has been complied with the resolution of the Authority shall be published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and from that time forward this bylaw shall have force and effect in the said designated public park.

#### CONDUCT OF PERSONS USING THE PARK

7 Except as may be authorized by the Authority or Director in writing or by a sign erected by the Authority or by a participating party, no person shall within a public park:

- (a) destroy, deface or remove any gate, fence, bridge, sign, building, firepit, firewood bin, or any materials temporarily or permanently in a public park for any authorized project or purpose;
- (b) uproot, fell or remove the whole or part of any shrub or tree;
- (c) damage or destroy any bird's nest or eggs, or beaver dam or the lair, den, hive, or home of any animal or set any trap, or snare, or injure, kill or attempt to injure or kill any wild animal or birds;
- (d) throw, dump or litter any material of any kind within a public park except in receptacles provided for that purpose;
- (e) start, make or kindle any fire except in barbecue pits or stands that are, or may be, erected for that purpose by the Authority or by a participating party; except in connection with a program that is authorized by the Authority or the Director and where the fire is started under the direction and supervision of a program leader or conservation officer;
- (f) permit any domestic animal to be within the public park except under proper control or pursuant to a lease entered into with the Authority or participating party that owns the public park; and
- (g) vend, solicit or advertise except by written permission of the Authority.

#### HOURS OF OPERATION

8(a) The Director may, from time to time, after consultation with the participating party that owns the public park, designate hours of the day when a public park or part thereof is to be closed to the public. During such designated hours, no person or vehicle shall enter the closed part of a public park except with the written authorization of the Director and any person already therein shall leave upon request by a police officer or conservation officer.

(b) Notwithstanding that the Director may not have consulted the participating party, the Director may designate that a public park or part thereof is temporarily closed if in the Director's opinion a natural or man-made emergency situation exists which threatens danger to a public park or to the health, property or safety of users of the public park. Where the Director has designated a public park or part thereof to be temporarily closed, no person or vehicle shall enter or remain in that public park or part thereof except with the approval of the Director;

(c) Notwithstanding that a public park may not be closed, a police officer or conservation officer may, at his or her discretion, request that a person or persons leave the public park at any time if the police officer or conservation officer believes on reasonable and probable grounds that the person or persons have committed or are about to commit a violation of any bylaw or provincial or federal statute or are conducting themselves in a manner that detracts from the enjoyment of the public park by other members of the public and upon such request the person or persons shall immediately leave the park.

#### FIREARMS

**9** No person except a duly authorized police officer or other person authorized in writing by the Chief Enforcement Officer shall discharge or have in his or her possession in a public park any firearm.

#### VEHICLES

**10(a)** Subject to subsection 10(b), no person shall drive, operate, park or move any vehicle anywhere in a public park except in those areas designated by the Authority as public parking areas or public roadways.

(b) Subsection 10(a) shall not apply to:

- (i) police vehicles, ambulances, fire trucks, or other equipment used in the prevention of fires, or other emergency vehicles;
- (ii) a vehicle necessarily incidental to the construction, operation, servicing or maintenance or a building, work, improvement, service facility, public utility, landscape construction or other construction project that has been authorized by the Authority or the Director;
- (iii) any other vehicle specifically authorized by the Authority or director to be in a public park;

(c) The maximum permitted speed limit in a public park, unless otherwise posted, shall be 20 kilometres per hour.

#### PENALTIES

**11(a)** Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to pay a fine of up to five hundred dollars and in default of payment the provisions of section 134 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* shall apply.

(b) Further to subsection 10(a), the following fines apply to any person parking a vehicle within a public park during the hours the public park is closed:

- (i) \$50 if payment is made or postmarked within 14 days of issue date; or
- (ii) \$75 after 14 calendar days of issue.

(c) A police officer may, without warrant, remove or cause the removal of any vehicle that, in his opinion:

- (i) is being operated in violation of this bylaw;
- (ii) has been stopped or parked in violation of this bylaw;

and may impound or store the vehicle until the payment of the cost of removal and impounding or storage is paid.

(d) Where a vehicle has been impounded or stored, under clause (b)(i), no person shall take it out of the possession of the person making the removal or storage from the place in which it has been stored without the written consent of a police officer.

(e) Upon payment of the cost of removal and impounding or storage of the vehicle, a police officer may release the vehicle to the owner.

(f) In the event that the cost of removal and impounding or storage is not paid within 30 days from the date of the removal or impounding or storage of the vehicle, the cost of the removal and impounding or storage may be recovered from the owner by an action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by a sale of the vehicle at public auction or by private sale.

#### ENFORCEMENT

**12** This bylaw is passed pursuant to section 2 of *The Meewasin Valley Authority Act* and pursuant to subsection 12(9) of that Act may be enforced in the same manner as bylaws of a municipality may be enforced under *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*, and for the purpose section 23 and sections 133 to 136 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* apply to this bylaw *mutatis mutandis*.

#### DATE ON WHICH BYLAW TAKES EFFECT

**13** This bylaw shall have force and effect on and after the date on which it is published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette*.

#### Schedule A

**1** Beaver Creek Conservation Area consists of the following land:

- (i) all of the northwest quarter of Section 6, Township 35, Range 5, West of the 3rd Meridian, except that portion lying southeast of Highway Number 219;
- (ii) all of the southwest quarter of Section 7, Township 35, Range 5, West of the 3rd Meridian that lies east of the east bank of the South Saskatchewan River;
- (iii) that portion of the northeast quarter of Section 1, Township 35, Range 6, West of the 3rd Meridian that lies north of Beaver Creek and east of the east bank of the South Saskatchewan River; and

- (ii) all that portion of the northwest quarter of Section 12, Township 36, Range 6, except all that portion described as follows:

#### BYLAW NUMBER 002 —

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE USE OF THE RIVER CHANNEL AND LANDS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF MEEWASIN VALLEY BY MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CORMAN PARK, NO. 344

#### Short Title

**1** This bylaw may be cited as the *Use of Vehicles Bylaw*.

#### INTERPRETATION

**2** In this bylaw:

- (a) "Authority" means the Meewasin Valley Authority;

- (b) **"Director"** means the Executive Director of the Authority;
- (c) **"Meewasin Valley"** means those areas and lands as defined in *The Meewasin Valley Authority Act*, being S.S. 1979, c.M.11.1, and amendments thereto and as may be amended from time to time;
- (d) **"Police Officer"** means a member of the police department of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park, a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or a conservation officer appointed by the Authority whose duties include the administration of bylaws enacted by the Authority;
- (e) **"River Channel"** means that portion of the South Saskatchewan River and river shore within the Meewasin Valley and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the beaches, islands, sandbars and shores of the aforesaid portion of the river;
- (f) **"Motorized Vehicle"** means any vehicle propelled or driven by any means other than by muscular power, but excluding snowmobiles as defined by *The Snowmobile Act*.

#### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

**3** To ensure the protection, care and preservation of property and to prevent injury to the river channel and to the lands within the jurisdiction of the Meewasin Valley Authority as hereinafter set forth.

#### APPLICATION

**4** This bylaw shall, upon coming into force, apply to:

- (a) that portion of the river channel as defined in paragraph 2(e) herein, in the Rural Municipality of Corman Park;
- (b) other lands within the jurisdiction of the Meewasin Valley Authority in the Rural Municipality of Corman Park, except those lands subject to the Public Parks Bylaw Number 001 of the Meewasin Valley Authority.

#### VEHICLE USE

**5(a)** Subject to the exceptions of subsection 5(b), no person shall drive, operate, park or move any motorized vehicle within the area of application of this bylaw.

- (b) Subsection 5(a) shall not apply to:
- (i) any vehicle operated on public roadways in accordance with existing laws and bylaws respecting the use of such roadways;
- (ii) police vehicles, ambulances, fire trucks or other equipment used in the prevention of fires, or other emergency vehicles;
- (iii) a vehicle necessarily incidental to the construction, operation, servicing or maintenance of irrigation systems, farming operations, service facility, public utility, landscape construction or other construction project that has been authorized by the Authority or the Director; and
- (iv) any other vehicle specifically authorized by the Authority or the Director to be on the river channel.

#### PENALTIES

**6(a)** Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to pay a fine of up to five hundred dollars and in default of payment the provisions of section 134 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* shall apply.

(b) Further to subsection 10(a), the following fines apply to any person driving, operating or parking a motorized vehicle within the area of application of this bylaw:

- (i) \$75 if payment is made or postmarked within 14 days of issue date; or
- (ii) \$100 after 14 calendar days of issue.

(c) A police Officer may, without warrant, remove or cause the removal of any vehicle that, in his opinion:

- (i) is being operated in violation of this bylaw;
- (ii) has been stopped or parked in violation of this bylaw;

and may impound or store the vehicle until the payment of the cost of removal and impounding or storage is paid.

(d) Where a vehicle has been impounded or stored, under clause (b)(i), no person shall take it out of the possession of the person making the removal or storage from the place in which it has been stored without the written consent of a police officer.

(e) Upon payment of the cost of removal and impounding or storage of the vehicle, a police officer may release the vehicle to the owner.

(f) In the event that the cost of removal and impounding or storage is not paid within 30 days from the date of the removal or impounding or storage of the vehicle, the cost of removal and impounding or storage may be recovered from the owner by an action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by a sale of the vehicle at public auction or by private sale.

#### ENFORCEMENT

**7** This bylaw is passed pursuant to section 2 of *The Meewasin Valley Authority Act* and pursuant to subsection of 12(9) of that Act may be enforced in the same manner as bylaws of a municipality may be enforced under *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*, and for that purpose section 23 and sections 133 to 136, both inclusive of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* apply to this bylaw *mutatis mutandis*.

### EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF SASKATCHEWAN RELATING TO PRIVATE BILLS

#### PETITIONS

**12(1)** A petition to the Assembly may be presented by a Member at any time during the sitting of the Assembly by filing the same with the Clerk of the Assembly.

(6) Petitions may be either written or printed, provided always that when there are three or more petitioners, the signatures of at least three petitioners shall be subscribed on the sheet containing the prayer of the petition.

(9) No petition can be received which prays for any expenditure, grant or charge on the public revenue, whether payable out of the Consolidated Fund or out of moneys to be provided by the Assembly.

NOTE: *A form of Petition can be obtained on application to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.*

#### PRIVATE BILLS

**64(1)** All petitions for Private Bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the twentieth sitting day of the Session.

(2) No petition for any Private Bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first twenty-five sitting days of the Session.

(3) No Private Bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first thirty sitting days of the Session.

**65(1)** Every applicant for a Private Bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition for same, two copies of the bill, with marginal notes inserted, and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, if the said bill does not exceed ten pages, and fifteen dollars additional for each page over that number, four hundred and fifty words shall be held to constitute a page.

(2) In the case of a bill incorporating a company, a receipt from the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk of the Assembly.

**66** No remittance of a deposit on account of a Private Bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the committee charged with its consideration, or unless the bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which cases the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance.

**68(1)** All petitions to the Legislature for Private Bills of any nature whatsoever, shall require a notice, clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and where the same refers to any proposed work, indicating generally the location of the work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same; and when the petition is for an act of incorporation the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

(2) Such notice shall be published prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in Rule 64(1) in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper, published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition and bill.

**69(2)** Every bill for an act of incorporation, where a form of model bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such model bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such bill which are not in accord with the model bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed.

**72** When any bill for confirming any agreement is filed with the Clerk of the Assembly a true copy of such agreement must be attached to it.

#### COMMITTEE RULING

In cases where the proposed bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

The name of the Member who is to present the petition and Private Bill must be furnished to the Clerk of the Assembly at the time of filing the petition. Such Member should not, of course, be a Member of the Cabinet.

### EXTRAITS DES RÈGLES ET PROCÉDURES DE L'ASSEMBLÉE LÉGISLATIVE DE LA SASKATCHEWAN AU SUJET DES PROJETS DE LOI D'INTÉRÊT PRIVÉ

#### PÉTITIONS

**12(1)** Les députés peuvent toujours présenter les pétitions à l'Assemblée pendant les séances en les déposant auprès du greffier.

(6) Les pétitions sont écrites ou imprimées; s'il y a plus que deux pétitionnaires, au moins trois de ceux-ci inscrivent leur signature sur la feuille qui expose la requête.

(9) Ne sont pas recevables, les pétitions qui demandent que soient faites sur les revenus publics, y compris le Trésor et les sommes allouées par l'Assemblée, des dépenses, des subventions ou des charges.

AVIS — *Un formulaire de pétition est disponible sur demande auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée législative.*

#### PROJETS DE LOI D'INTÉRÊT PRIVÉ

**64(1)** Deux exemplaires des pétitions introductives de projets de loi d'intérêt privé sont déposés auprès du greffier dans les vingt jours de séance de l'ouverture de la session.

(2) Seules sont recevables par l'Assemblée, les pétitions introductives de projet de loi d'intérêt privé qui sont présentées dans les vingt-cinq jours de séance de l'ouverture de la session.

(3) Les projets de loi d'intérêt privé ne peuvent être déposés à l'Assemblée que dans les trente jours de séance de l'ouverture de la session.

**65(1)** Les personnes qui demandent un projet de loi d'intérêt privé déposent auprès du greffier, outre la pétition connexe, deux exemplaires du projet de loi qui portent les notes marginales ainsi qu'un chèque visé payable au ministre des Finances, au montant de deux cent cinquante dollars si le projet de loi est composé d'au plus dix pages; ce montant est majoré de quinze dollars par page supplémentaire. Une page est réputée renfermer quatre cent cinquante mots.

(2) Si le projet de loi prévoit la constitution d'une société, le récépissé des droits réglementaires donné par le registraire des sociétés par action est également déposé auprès du greffier.

**66** L'Assemblée ne peut ordonner la remise totale ou partielle des dépôts relatifs aux projets de loi d'intérêt privé, sauf recommandation du comité chargé d'étudier le projet en question ou si celui-ci est retiré ou rejeté ou encore n'est pas rapporté. Les dépenses réelles sont déduites du dépôt avant de le remettre.

**68(1)** Toutes les pétitions introductives de projets de loi d'intérêt privé à l'adresse de la Législature nécessitent un avis qui expose clairement la nature et l'objet de la demande et qui est signé par les requérants et en leur nom, avec mention de l'adresse des signataires. Les avis qui visent des travaux proposés font état de leur site; ceux qui visent une loi de constitution en société font état du nom de la société.

(2) Les avis sont publiés, avant le dépôt de la pétition auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée conformément au paragraphe 64(1), dans deux numéros consécutifs de *la Gazette de la Saskatchewan* ainsi que dans quatre numéros consécutifs d'un journal anglais diffusé dans la région touchée.

(3) Sont déposées auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée, outre la pétition et le projet de loi, copie de l'avis ainsi qu'une déclaration solennelle qui atteste les diverses publications de l'annonce.

**69(2)** Si une formule-type de projet de loi a été adoptée, les projets de loi portant constitution des sociétés sont rédigés selon cette formule, dont les exemplaires sont disponibles chez le greffier de l'Assemblée. Les dispositions de ces projets de loi qui ne se conforment pas à la formule-type sont indiquées et imprimées entre crochets.

**72** Une copie conforme de l'accord est annexée aux projets de loi portant ratification d'un accord, qui sont déposés auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée.

#### DÉCISION EN COMITÉ

Dans les cas où la proposition de projet de loi prévoit que les biens devant être utilisés ou occupés par le requérant soient exempts d'impôts, que ce soit dans leur ensemble ou partiellement, le requérant devra déposer au bureau du greffier de l'Assemblée en plus de sa pétition, une déclaration par écrit des autorités municipales locales où se trouvent les biens en question approuvant l'objet des dispositions de la proposition de projet de loi qui prévoit l'exemption d'impôts.

Le nom du député qui présentera la pétition et le projet de loi doit être fourni au greffier de l'Assemblée lors du dépôt de la pétition. Il est entendu que le député en question ne peut être un membre du Cabinet.
