Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Provincial Court Compensation Amendment Regulations, 2012*.

2 *The Provincial Court Compensation Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Section 3 amended

3(1) Subsection 3(2) is amended by repealing clause (j) and substituting the following:

“(j) \$238,943 for the period commencing on April 1, 2011 and ending on March 31, 2012;

“(k) for the period commencing on April 1, 2012 and ending on March 31, 2013, S_1 calculated in accordance with the following formula and rounded up to the nearest dollar:

$$S_1 = (\$238,943 + (\$238,943 \times C)) \times 1.01$$

where the value of C is to be calculated using the consumer price index for the 2011 calendar year as CPI_1 and the consumer price index for the 2010 calendar year as CPI_2 ;

“(l) for the period commencing on April 1, 2013 and ending on March 31, 2014, S_2 calculated in accordance with the following formula and rounded up to the nearest dollar:

$$S_2 = (S_1 + (S_1 \times C)) \times 1.01$$

where:

(i) S_1 is the amount S_1 calculated pursuant to clause (k); and

(ii) the value of C is to be calculated using the consumer price index for the 2012 calendar year as CPI_1 and the consumer price index for the 2011 calendar year as CPI_2 ;

“(m) for the period commencing on April 1, 2014, S_3 calculated in accordance with the following formula and rounded up to the nearest dollar:

$$S_3 = (S_2 + (S_2 \times C)) \times 1.01$$

where:

- (i) S_2 is the amount S_2 calculated pursuant to clause (l); and
- (ii) the value of C is to be calculated using the consumer price index for the 2013 calendar year as CPI_1 and the consumer price index for the 2012 calendar year as CPI_2 .

(2) Subsection 3(5) is amended by repealing clause (j) and substituting the following:

“(j) for the period commencing on April 1, 2011 and ending on March 31, 2012, \$1086 for each day and \$543 for each half day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge;

“(k) for the period commencing on April 1, 2012 and ending on March 31, 2013:

- (i) for each day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge, the amount D_1 calculated in accordance with the following formula and rounded up to the nearest dollar:

$$D_1 = (\$1086 + (\$1086 \times C)) \times 1.01$$

where the value of C is to be calculated using the consumer price index for the 2011 calendar year as CPI_1 and the consumer price index for the 2010 calendar year as CPI_2 ; and

- (ii) for each half day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge, one-half of the amount D_1 calculated in accordance with subclause (i) and rounded up to the nearest dollar;

“(l) for the period commencing on April 1, 2013 and ending on March 31, 2014:

- (i) for each day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge, the amount D_2 calculated in accordance with the following formula and rounded up to the nearest dollar:

$$D_2 = (D_1 + (D_1 \times C)) \times 1.01$$

where:

- (A) D_1 is the amount D_1 calculated pursuant to subclause (k)(i); and

(B) the value of C is to be calculated using the consumer price index for the 2012 calendar year as CPI_1 and the consumer price index for the 2011 calendar year as CPI_2 ; and

- (ii) for each half day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge, one-half of the amount D_2 calculated in accordance with subclause (i) and rounded up to the nearest dollar;

“(m) for the period commencing on April 1, 2014:

(i) for each day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge, the amount D_3 calculated in accordance with the following formula and rounded up to the nearest dollar:

$$D_3 = (D_2 + (D_2 \times C)) \times 1.01$$

where:

(A) D_2 is the amount D_2 calculated pursuant to subclause (l)(i); and

(B) the value of C is to be calculated using the consumer price index for the 2013 calendar year as CPI_1 and the consumer price index for the 2012 calendar year as CPI_2 ; and

(ii) for each half day in which the temporary judge is engaged in his or her duties as a judge, one-half of the amount D_3 calculated in accordance with subclause (i) and rounded up to the nearest dollar”.

Section 6 amended

4 Subsection 6(2) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(2) For the period commencing on April 1, 2006 and ending on March 31, 2012, a judge is entitled to be paid an accountable professional allowance of \$3,500 per year.

“(3) For the period commencing on April 1, 2012, a judge is entitled to be paid an accountable professional allowance of \$3,650 per year”.
