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#### BRYANT SOUTH MIDALE BEDS POOL

MRO 236/02 PB 30. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, the following area is designated and identified as an oil and gas pool named the "Bryant South Midale Beds Pool", effective May 1, 2002:

Lands West of the Second Meridian:

In Township 5, Range 8: the north-west quarter of Section 4;  
Section 5.

MRO 237/02 PO 16. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, the following provisions shall apply to the drilling of, and the production of oil and gas from, vertical oil wells in the Bryant South Midale Beds Pool, effective May 1, 2002:

1 The drainage unit shall be comprised of two legal subdivisions in a Section grouped as follows:

Legal subdivisions 1 and 2; 3 and 4; 5 and 6; 7 and 8; 9 and 10; 11 and 12; 13 and 14; 15 and 16.

2 Within a drainage unit, the sides of the target area shall be 100 m from and parallel to the corresponding sides of the odd-numbered legal subdivision.

#### LIEBENTHAL MILK RIVER GAS POOL

MRO 247/02 PO 17. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 318/01 PO 18, dated May 9, 2001, is rescinded and the following provisions shall apply to the drilling of, and production from, gas wells in the "Liebenthal Milk River Gas Pool", effective May 1, 2002:

1 The drainage unit for the drilling and completion of a gas well shall be four legal subdivisions grouped as follows:

Legal subdivisions 1, 2, 7 and 8; 3, 4, 5 and 6; 9, 10, 15, and 16; 11, 12, 13 and 14;

with the exception of the area described in clause 2(a) in which the drainage unit shall be comprised of two legal subdivisions in a Section, grouped as follows:

Legal subdivisions 1 and 2; 3 and 4; 5 and 6; 7 and 8; 9 and 10; 11 and 12; 13 and 14; 15 and 16.

2(a) Within a drainage unit, the target area shall be a square with sides of 235 m situated in the north-east corner of legal subdivisions 6, 8, 14 and 16, with the exception of the following lands lying West of the Third Meridian:

In Township 18, Range 24: Sections 29 to 32;  
 In Township 19, Range 24: Sections 5 to 9, 16 to 21, 28 to 33;  
 In Township 20, Range 24: Sections 5 to 7;  
 In Township 18, Range 25: all Sections;  
 In Township 19, Range 25: Sections 1 to 8, 10 to 15, 22 to 28 and 33 to 36;  
 In Township 20, Range 25: Sections 1 to 4, 8 to 14, 15 to 18, 20 to 22, 27, 28, and 33 to 36;  
 In Township 21, Range 25: Sections 1 to 17;  
 In Township 18, Range 26: Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36;  
 In Township 19, Range 26: Sections 1 to 7, 9 to 15 and 18;

where the target area shall be a square with sides of 235 metres situated in the north-east corner of legal subdivisions 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 and 16;

(b) the approval of the Rural Municipality shall be obtained prior to drilling a well closer than 75 m to a road allowance, but no wells shall be drilled within 35 m of a road allowance.

3 All gas wells drilled to or completed in this pool prior to May 1, 2002 shall be considered to be drilled on-target as prescribed by section 2.

4 Unless otherwise ordered by the minister, every well shall be flow tested within three months after commencement of production in a manner approved by the minister and any such flow tests are made in lieu of subsections 73(1) and (2) of the regulations under *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*.

5 The operator shall have the following logs taken as a minimum requirement for gas wells drilled to this pool:

(a) for at least one well per Section, an approved resistivity log or standard electric log shall be run; or

(b) an approved pulsed neutron capture log may be substituted for the requirements of subsection (a);

(c) the remaining wells on a Section shall be logged with an approved radioactivity log consisting of both natural and induced radioactivity measurements, or in accordance with subsections (a) or (b);

(d) all logs shall be run over the interval from the surface casing shoe to total depth.

#### BURSTALL MILK RIVER GAS POOL BURSTALL MEDICINE HAT SAND GAS POOL BURSTALL MILK RIVER-MEDICINE HAT GAS POOL

MRO 248/02 PO 18. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 322/01 PO 19, dated May 11, 2001, is rescinded and the pool provisions in the following schedule shall apply to the drilling of, and production from, gas wells in the Burstall Milk River Gas Pool, Burstall Medicine Hat Sand Gas Pool and Burstall Milk River-Medicine Hat Gas Pool, effective May 1, 2002.

Dated at Regina, Saskatchewan, April 18, 2002.

#### Schedule

1 The drainage unit for the drilling and completion of a gas well shall be two legal subdivisions in a Section grouped as follows:

Legal subdivisions 1 and 2; 3 and 4; 5 and 6; 7 and 8; 9 and 10; 11 and 12; 13 and 14; 15 and 16;

with the exception of the following drainage units which shall be:

(a) the fractional quarter Section containing approximately 36 hectares (ha) within the area described in clause 2(a);

2 Within a drainage unit, the target area shall be a 235 m square situated in the north-east corner of legal subdivisions 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 and 16, with the exception of the following:

(a) the target area shall be a 235 m square situated in the north-east corner of legal subdivisions 8 and 16 within the following lands West of the Third Meridian:

In Township 19, Range 29: fractional Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31;

In Township 20, Range 29: fractional Sections 6 and 7;

(b) no wells shall be drilled within 300 m of the south boundary of the following lands West of the Third Meridian:

In Township 19, Range 28: Sections 3 to 6;

In Township 19, Range 29: Sections 1 to 5;

(c) the approval of the Rural Municipality shall be obtained prior to drilling a well closer than 75 m to a road allowance, but no wells shall be drilled within 35 m of a road allowance.

3 All gas wells drilled to or completed in this pool prior to May 1, 2002, shall be considered to be drilled on target as prescribed in section 2.

4 Unless otherwise ordered by the minister, every well shall be flow tested within 3 months after commencement of production in a manner approved by the minister and any such flow tests may be made in lieu of subsections 73(1), and (2) of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Regulations, 1985*.

5 The operator shall have the following logs as a minimum requirement for gas wells drilled to this pool:

(a) for at least one well per Section, an approved resistivity log or standard electric log shall be run;

(b) an approved pulsed neutron capture log may be substituted for the requirements of clause 5(a);

(c) the remaining wells on a Section shall be logged with an approved radioactivity log, consisting of both natural and induced radioactivity measurements, or in accordance with clauses 5(a) or (b);

(d) all logs shall be run over the interval from the surface casing shoe to total depth.

6 Unless otherwise ordered by the minister, wells shall be produced according to Good Production Practice.

7 Commingling of production from the Milk River Formation and the Medicine Hat Sand shall be permitted except where the following conditions apply:

(a) on lands where the Milk River Formation and the Medicine Hat Sand have a different royalty interest ownership;

(b) where the well density is greater than one well per Section the production from the Milk River Formation and the Medicine Hat Sand shall be segregated in at least one location in every four Section square;

(c) if water production exceeds that amount of water used for completion and stimulation purposes and water of condensation, production shall be stopped immediately and the well converted to a single formation or dual producer unless it can be demonstrated to the Department's satisfaction that corrective procedures have been successful.

MRO 249/02 PB 31. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 512/01 PB 26, dated July 24, 2001, is rescinded and the following area is designated and identified as gas pools named the "Burstall Milk River Gas Pool", "Burstall Medicine Hat Sand Gas Pool", and "Burstall Milk River-Medicine Hat Gas Pool", effective May 1, 2002:

Lands West of the Third Meridian:

In Township 19, Range 27: Sections 1 to 18;

In Township 19, Range 28: Sections 1 to 24 and 27 to 34;

In Township 20, Range 28: Sections 4 to 9, 14 to 23, 28 to 30, 32 and 33;

In Township 21, Range 28: Sections 4 and 5;

In Township 19, Range 29: Sections 1 to 5, fractional Sections 6 and 7, Sections 8 to 17, fractional Sections 18 and 19, Sections 20 to 29, fractional Sections 30 and 31, and Sections 32 to 36;

In Township 20, Range 29: Sections 1 to 5, fractional Sections 6 and 7, Sections 8 to 16 and Section 24.

MRO 250/02 PO 19. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 528/01 PO 31, dated July 31, 2001, is rescinded and the following provisions shall apply to the drilling of vertical oil wells, and production of oil and gas from, vertical and horizontal oil wells in the Wapella Mannville Sand Pool, effective May 1, 2002:

3 It is deemed appropriate and in the public interest to change the name of the Organized Hamlet of Espeseth Cove at this time. The undersigned, therefore issues an Order pursuant to section 8 of *The Rural Municipality Act, 1989* to:

- (a) change the name of the Organized Hamlet of Espeseth Cove to the Organized Hamlet of Pelican Shores; and
- (b) confirm that the change of name shall take effect on and from the date this Order is signed.

**EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND  
PROCEDURES OF THE LEGISLATIVE  
ASSEMBLY OF SASKATCHEWAN  
RELATING TO PRIVATE BILLS**

PETITIONS

12(1) A petition to the Assembly may be presented by a Member at any time during the sitting of the Assembly by filing the same with the Clerk of the Assembly.

(6) Petitions may be either written or printed, provided always that when there are three or more petitioners, the signatures of at least three petitioners shall be subscribed on the sheet containing the prayer of the petition.

(9) No petition can be received which prays for any expenditure, grant or charge on the public revenue, whether payable out of the Consolidated Fund or out of moneys to be provided by the Assembly.

NOTE: A form of Petition can be obtained on application to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.

## PRIVATE BILLS

64(1) All petitions for Private Bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the twentieth sitting day of the Session.

(2) No petition for any Private Bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first twenty-five sitting days of the Session.

(3) No Private Bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first thirty sitting days of the Session.

65(1) Every applicant for a Private Bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition for same, two copies of the bill, with marginal notes inserted, and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, if the said bill does not exceed ten pages, and fifteen dollars additional for each page over that number, four hundred and fifty words shall be held to constitute a page.

(2) In the case of a bill incorporating a company, a receipt from the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk of the Assembly.

66 No remittance of a deposit on account of a Private Bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the committee charged with its consideration, or unless the bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which cases the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance.

68(1) All petitions to the Legislature for Private Bills of any nature whatsoever, shall require a notice, clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and where the same refers to any proposed work, indicating generally the location of the work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same; and when the petition is for an act of incorporation the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

(2) Such notice shall be published prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in Rule 64(1) in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper, published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition and bill.

69(2) Every bill for an act of incorporation, where a form of model bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such model bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such bill which are not in accord with the model bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed.

72 When any bill for confirming any agreement is filed with the Clerk of the Assembly a true copy of such agreement must be attached to it.

## COMMITTEE RULING

In cases where the proposed bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

The name of the Member who is to present the petition and Private Bill must be furnished to the Clerk of the Assembly at the time of filing the petition. Such Member should not, of course, be a Member of the Cabinet.
