The Municipalities Act

[sections 53, 56, 57, 59, 61, 62 and 63]

ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES – BETWEEN THE TOWN OF BALGONIE AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF EDENWOLD NO. 158

- 1 Pursuant to sections 53, 56, 57, 59, and 61 of *The Municipalities Act*, the Council of the Town of Balgonie has submitted an application to alter its boundaries to the Minister of Government Relations.
- **2** Upon consideration of the application, the Minister is of the opinion that the municipalities affected will be viable entities following the alteration of boundaries. Therefore, the undersigned hereby orders, pursuant to sections 61, 62, and 63 of *The Municipalities Act*, that:
 - (a) the boundaries of the Town of Balgonie and the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158 be altered by withdrawing from the rural municipality and adding to the town the territory described in Schedule A;
 - (b) Schedule B is conclusively deemed to be the legal description of the boundary of the Town of Balgonie; and
 - (c) the alteration shall take effect on and from the date of this Order.

SCHEDULE A

The boundaries of the Town of Balgonie are altered by adding to the town and withdrawing from the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 63 the following lands lying within:

- (1) Township 17, Range 17, West of the Second Meridian and described as:
 - (a) all that portion of Section 33, lying north and west of the northerly and westerly boundary of the Trans-Canada Highway right-of-way shown on Plan No. 61R28095, Ext. 1 including the road allowance bounding the north and west limits of the section north of Provincial Highway No. 1;

EXCEPTING all that portion of Provincial Highway No. 46 right-of-way shown on Plan No. 91R38302 and the service road shown on Plan No. 101849643, Ext. 0.

- (2) Township 18, Range 17, West of the Second Meridian and described as:
 - (a) all that portion of the south-west quarter Section 4:
 - (i) Surface Parcel No. 109982346, Ext. 3 lying south of the southern boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way shown on Plan No. 16074 and lying east of the eastern boundary of Provinical Highway No. 46 right-of-way shown on Plan No. 91R38304, Ext. 1.

Unless otherwise specified, the sections and portions of sections described in the above schedules include the adjoining south and west roads, intersections thereof and widenings thereto by plan of survey.

For description purposes, the land acquired by plan of survey for widening to an adjoining road allowance is deemed to be part of the road allowance.

The said plans of survey are of record with Information Services Corporation of Saskatchewan.

The boundaries of the Town of Balgonie shall comprise the territory in the Province of Saskatchewan lying within:

- (1) Township 17, Range 17, West of the Second Meridian and described as:
 - (a) all that portion of Section 33, lying north and west of the northerly and westerly boundary of the Trans-Canada Highway right-of-way shown on Plan No. 61R28095, Ext. 1 including the road allowance bounding the north and west limits of the section north of Provinical Highway No. 1;

EXCEPTING all that portion of Provinical Highway No. 46 right-of-way shown on Plan No. 91R38302 and the service road shown on Plan No. 101849643, Ext. 0.

- (2) Township 18, Range 17, West of the Second Meridian and described as:
 - (a) Section 3;
