The Bottom Line

- We're investing in the future to ensure long-term growth, and to provide a return on **your** investment!
- Investments in education enable growing businesses to hire the skilled young people they need.
- The Corporate Income Tax rate for manufacturers in Saskatchewan can be as low as 10% (depending on the type of operation).
- 6% refundable tax credit for investment in manufacturing and processing equipment facilities.
- The Saskatchewan Commercial Innovation Incentive offers eligible corporations a reduction of the provincial Corporate Income Tax rate to 6% for a period of 10 years or 15 years depending on where R&D takes place.
- Saskatchewan offers a 10% refundable provincial income tax credit for scientific research and development expenditures. For Saskatchewan Canadian-controlled private corporations, the credit is refundable on the first \$1 million of qualifying annual expenditures. In all over cases, it is non-refundable.
- Manufacturing and Processing Exporter Tax incentives provide non-refundable tax credits to eligible exporting companies that increase their number of employees. If eligible, the company will receive a \$3,000 tax credit for each production-level job created or \$10,000 tax credit for each head officer job created.
