Sign Specifications

Sign Size: Variable

Legend Size &Type: 15 & 12.5 cm, Clearview



Distance to be included if the facility is not visible from the highway.

Policy Upon request, the Ministry may install at the access of the highway and the intersecting road leading to the shrine, GS-68 Shrine guide signs for shrines that are located outside the incorporated limits of an urban community.

Eligibility The shrine will:

- be of general interest and open at no charge to the public;
- hold special events and celebrations from time to time;
- be operated by a non-profit charitable organization; and
- have received permission to the rural municipality to direct traffic along the municipal road.

Conditions The applicant will:

- waive the right to install off premise private signs; and
- provide all other auxiliary signing required on the route between the provincial highway and the shrine. All auxiliary signing will be in place prior to the installation of the highway signs. Applicants are advised to discuss their auxiliary signing requirements with the Ministry and the local government.

Application The application will be made to the Ministry on a standard Shrine Sign application form.

Costs The applicant will be required to pay the current cost of the signs at a cost as described in the Roadside Management Manual (RSMM) Part II Sign Pricing Policy 1050-10.

Removal Signs may be removed, if in the opinion of the Ministry, the terms of the application are not being met.
