

SEISMIC EXPLORATION PROGRAM

GUIDELINES

When seismic lines extend over other mineral dispositions or surface leases

A mineral disposition confers to the holder the exclusive right to explore for the commodities described in the applicable regulations. A surface lease confers to the holder the right to control access to the surface of the lease.

On top and above any other condition that may be imposed by the Minister, approval of a seismic program whose lines extend over a disposition(s) not held by the applicant and issued under *The Mineral Disposition Regulations 1986*, *The Subsurface Mineral Regulations 1960*, *The Coal Disposition Regulations 1988*, *The Quarrying Regulations 1957* and/or *The Alkali Mining Regulations*, shall be conditional to the applicant providing copy of the written consent from the holder(s) of the disposition(s) over which the lines are to extend.

On top and above any other condition that may be imposed by the Minister, approval of a seismic program whose lines extend over a surface lease(s) not held by the applicant shall be conditional to the applicant providing copy of the written consent from the holder(s) of surface lease(s) over which the lines are to extend.

The written consent shall clearly identify the capacity and identity of the individual providing consent as well as their phone number.
