

Affidavit B
Collection Line, Distribution Line or Service Connection

Sections 122(1)(e), 122(4) and 123(2) of The Planning and Development Act, 2007

- This Affidavit may be used in lieu of a Certificate of Approval for a right-of-way shown on a plan of survey or Descriptive Plan Type II, **IF** the plan encompasses a collection line, distribution line, or service connection.
- A completed affidavit must be submitted to the Information Services Corporation (ISC) when applying for approval of a plan from the Controller of Surveys.
- A completed affidavit does not eliminate the need to obtain any permits required from a municipality or other government authorities.
