- This affidavit may be used in lieu of a Certificate of Approval for a right-of-way when registering a subdividing interest, **IF** the instrument encompasses a collection line, distribution line, or service connection.
- A completed affidavit must be submitted to the Information Services Corporation (ISC) along with the application of interest registration or interest amendment.
- A completed affidavit does not eliminate the need to obtain any permits required from a municipality or other government authorities.
