3 The following section is added after section 6:

"6.1(1) In this section, 'gross sales of coal related to a Crown lease' means gross sales of coal that are derived directly or indirectly from the sale or other disposition of coal extracted, recovered or produced from or allocated to Crown coal lands that are subject to the lease.

"(2) For the quarter commencing on July 1, 1988 and for each subsequent quarter, the royalty payer may deduct from his royalty payment pursuant to section 6 the Saskatchewan resource credit equal to one percent of his gross sales of coal related to a Crown lease for that quarter.

"(3) For the purposes of subsection (2), ex-mine costs mentioned in clause 5(1)(a) shall not be deducted in determining gross sales of coal pursuant to section 5".

4 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations, but are retroactive and are deemed to have been in force on and from July 8, 1988.
