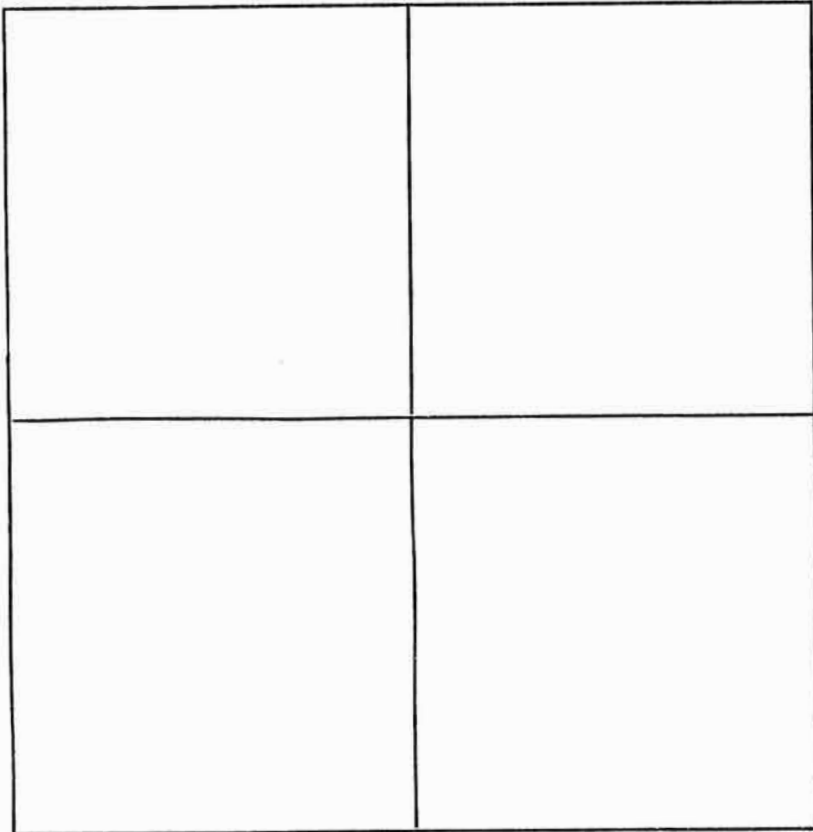

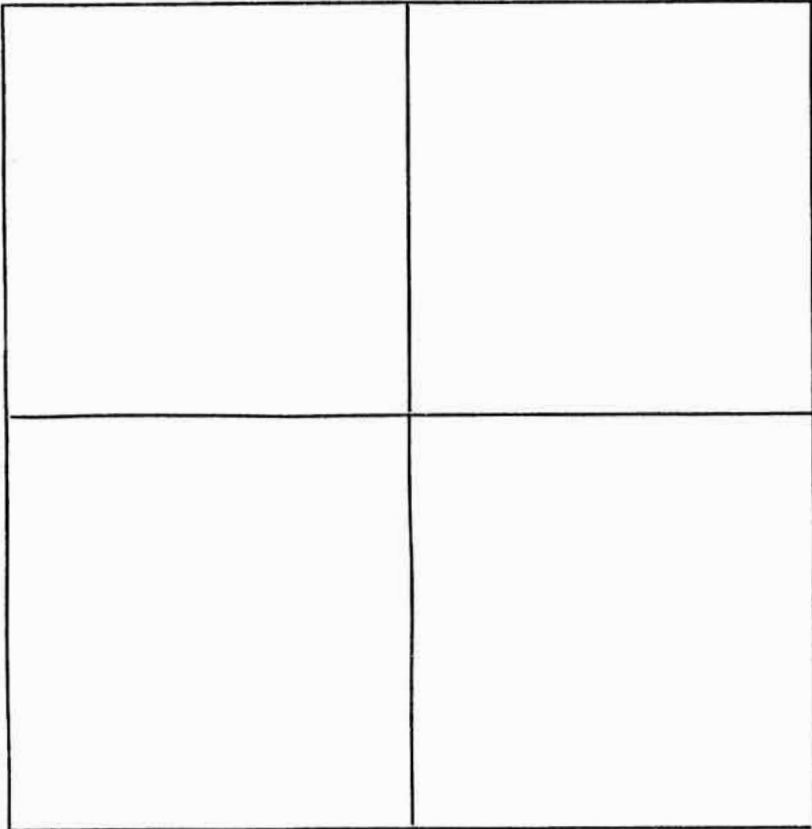

- Constitution of historic sites **2** The lands described in the Appendix are hereby constituted historic sites to be known by the names set out in the Appendix.

APPENDIX

Alsask Recreation Site

NOTE: All plans referred to are plans of record in the Land Titles Office for the Saskatoon Land Registration District.

That portion of the south-east quarter of Section 15, in Township 28, in Range 29, west of the Third Meridian, bounded:

- (a) on the south by the southern boundary of the quarter section;

- (b) on the east by the western limit of a roadway, as shown on Plan No. FV 524;
- (c) on the north by the south-eastern limit of the roadway described in clause (b);
- (d) on the west by the north-eastern limit of Parcel B, as shown on Plan No. 61 S 22199.

Amisk Lake Recreation Site

“(11) Where a producer delivers an average of less than 250 kilograms of milk per day for a month, the producer is deemed to be a cream producer and shall deliver only cream for manufacture until he proves, to the satisfaction of the board, that he has the capacity to deliver an average of 250 kilograms of milk per day for a month.

“(12) No cream producer shall deliver milk, other than cream, to a dairy processing plant”.

6 Section 8 is repealed and the following substituted: New sections 8 to 8.7

“**8**(1) No producer shall transfer all or part of his total production quota except: Approval required to transfer

(a) in accordance with this section and sections 8.1 to 8.7; and

“(2) A producer who wishes to transfer all or part of his total production quota shall:

(a) apply to the board on the form provided by the board; and

(b) supply the board with any information that the board may require with respect to the application.

“**8.1**(1) Where the board approves the transfer of all or part of a total production quota, 20% of the total production quota to be transferred is to be returned to the board and placed in the Saskatchewan reserve. Conditions on transfer

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to transfers within the immediate family if the transferee holds the total production quota so transferred for at least five years and, for the purposes of this subsection, any transfer of any part of the transferee's total production quota to an immediate family member in that five year period is deemed to be a transfer of the equivalent amount of the total production quota transferred to him.

“(3) Subject to subsection (5), subsection (1) does not apply to transfers in connection with the purchase of a complete dairy unit that is, in the opinion of the board, purchased as a going concern.

“(4) Subject to subsection (6), subsection (1) does not apply to transfers:

(a) that are of 12 months or less in duration;

(b) that are the result of a catastrophe, with respect to which a producer files a notice with the board in accordance with section 10; and

(c) where the transferee is the owner of the land on which the transferor's milking cows are kept.

"(5) Where the purchaser of a complete dairy unit described in subsection (3) sells that unit within five years of the date that he purchased it and transfers his total production quota in connection with the sale with the result that the total production quota is to be filled from another location, the board may order the transferee of the total production quota in connection with that sale to return to the board, where the sale takes place:

(a) in the first year after the date of its purchase by the transferor, 20%;

(b) in the second year after the date of its purchase by the transferor, 15%;

(c) in the third year after the date of its purchase by the transferor, 10%;

(d) in the fourth year after the date of its purchase by the transferor, 6%;

(e) in the fifth year after the date of its purchase by the transferor, 2%;

of the total production quota so transferred.

"(6) If a transfer described in subsection (4) exceeds one year, the board may order that subsection (1) applies to the transfer.

"8.2 For the purposes of calculating the total production quota in the case of a transfer of a complete dairy unit and a total production quota, 100 kilograms of milk is equal to 3.5 kilograms of butterfat.

"8.3(1) Subject to subsection (2), the board shall not approve the transfer of only part of a producer's total production quota.

"(2) The board may approve, subject to any terms and conditions that it considers appropriate:

(a) a transfer of part of a producer's total production quota to an immediate family member of the producer;

(b) the transfer of part of a producer's total production quota to another producer and the remainder of a producer's total production quota to other producers, if the result is to split all of the producer's total production quota amongst other producers.

“(3) Where a producer proposes to transfer his total production quota to a person who is not a milk producer, the board shall not approve the transfer unless:

- (a) the board is satisfied that the location where the person proposes to produce milk is appropriate; and
- (b) the production facilities to be used by the person are approved pursuant to *The Animal Products Act* and the regulations made pursuant to that Act.

“(4) The board may approve the transfer by two or more producers who are individuals of their total production quotas to a partnership or association of which they are members or shareholders.

“(5) Where a producer who is an individual:

- (a) has transferred his total production quota to a partnership or association in accordance with subsection (4); and
- (b) subsequent to the transfer mentioned in clause (a), applies to the board to withdraw from the partnership or association and to retransfer his total production quota to his own name;

the board may approve the transfer and may order that subsection 8.1(5) applies *mutatis mutandis* to that producer and that retransfer.

“(6) The board may refuse to approve a transfer of all or any part of a total production quota if, as a result of the transfer, the total production quota of the transferee would exceed 4,500 kilograms per day.

“**8.4** If a total production quota is returned to the board or is otherwise available to be distributed among producers, the board shall distribute the total production quota in the following manner:

- (e) that the terms and conditions of service are those prescribed in this section.

“(4) The following terms and conditions of service apply to each person appointed as a ministerial assistant pursuant to subsection (1):

- (a) section 4, subsections 5(3) and 6(1), clauses 6(2)(a) and (b), subsection 6(3), sections 12 and 13, subsection 14(1) and section 15 of these regulations apply *mutatis mutandis*;
- (b) in lieu of statutory and designated holidays, each ministerial assistant is to be paid, for each pay period 5% of his regular earnings in that pay period, not including pay in lieu of vacation leave;
- (c) each ministerial assistant is to be paid in lieu of vacation leave as follows:
 - (i) in the first to ninth years of service with the Government of Saskatchewan or any board, commission or crown corporation of the Government of Saskatchewan, at the rate of 6% of his total earnings in each pay period;
 - (ii) in the tenth to nineteenth years of service with the Government of Saskatchewan or any board, commission or crown corporation of the Government of Saskatchewan, at the rate of 8% of his total earnings in each pay period;
 - (iii) in the twentieth to twenty-ninth years of service with the Government of Saskatchewan or any board, commission or crown corporation of the Government of Saskatchewan, at the rate of 10% of his total earnings in each pay period;
 - (iv) in the thirtieth and year of service and each year of service thereafter with the Government of Saskatchewan or any board, commission or crown corporation of the Government of Saskatchewan, at the rate of 12% of his total earnings in each pay period;
- (d) each ministerial assistant is to earn and accumulate 1 1/4 days sick leave with pay for each 22 full days worked

and unused sick leave credits are to be accumulated except when periods of service are interrupted by resignation, dismissal or a period of when he is otherwise not so employed of more than 180 days;

(f) where a ministerial assistant wishes to resign, he shall give seven days written notice of his resignation to the minister;

(g) on completion of 260 full days worked, the minister shall assess the level of performance of the ministerial assistant and determine any change in the rate of fees payable within the fee range, and any change in the rate of fees is effective on the first working day following the completion of the 260 days worked".

Reciprocal Pension Transfer Agreements

"42.1 In this Part:

(a) 'exporting plan' means a pension plan from which a transfer of pension benefit credits is made pursuant to a reciprocal pension transfer agreement;

Interpretation

'exporting plan'

(b) 'importing plan' means a pension plan to which a transfer of pension benefit credits is made pursuant to a reciprocal pension transfer agreement;

'importing plan'

(c) 'reciprocal pension transfer agreement' means an agreement providing for the transfer of pension benefit credits of an employee from an exporting plan to an importing plan between:

'reciprocal pension transfer agreement'

(i) an employer who has established a pension plan or the administrator or trustee of that plan; and

(ii) an employer who has established, anywhere in Canada, another pension plan or the administrator or trustee of that other pension plan.

"42.2 An employer who has established a pension plan or the administrator or trustee of that plan may, on the request of an employee whose employment has terminated and whose membership in the pension plan has terminated, transfer

Transfer to importing plan

pension benefit credits of that employee to an importing plan pursuant to the terms of a reciprocal pension transfer agreement which agreement has been approved by and filed with the superintendent.

Approval “**42.3** The superintendent shall not approve a reciprocal pension transfer agreement unless he is satisfied that the importing plan provides contractually that all pension benefit credits of an employee which:

(a) are transferred to it from an exporting plan established in Saskatchewan; and

(b) were locked in pursuant to section 16 of the Act;

are to be used during the life of the employee solely for the purpose of providing a life annuity.

Exemption from Act “**42.4(1)** An exporting plan established in Saskatchewan is exempted from section 16 of the Act to the extent that is necessary to give effect to a transfer of pension benefit credits pursuant to section 42.2.

“(2) A transfer of pension benefit credits made pursuant to this Part is deemed not to be an assignment, charge, attachment, anticipation or giving as security of moneys payable under a pension plan for the purposes of section 19 of the Act.

Liability “**42.5** A transfer of pension benefit credits of an employee made pursuant to this Part operates to discharge the liability of the exporting plan to the employee to the extent of the amount transferred.

Application of certain sections “**42.6** The superintendent may approve a reciprocal pension transfer agreement that was entered into prior to the coming into force of this section and, when such an agreement is approved, sections 42.4 and 42.5 apply *mutatis mutandis* to any transfer of pension benefit credits made pursuant to that agreement”.
