The Regulations printed in this Part of the Gazette form a part of *The Revised Regulations of Saskatchewan* which are being compiled over the next few years. This part contains revised regulations and amendments to revised regulations. Amendments to existing regulations, which are not yet revised, are printed in Part III.

CHAPTER H-3 REG 5

The Highways and Transportation Act

Clause 2(k)

Order in Council 578/84, dated May 3, 1984.

(Filed May 4, 1984)

ORDER

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Highways and Transportation, pursuant to clause 2(k) of *The Highways and Transportation Act*, makes *The Provincial Highway Designation Regulations* in accordance with the attached Schedule.

SCHEDULE

- 1 These regulations may be cited as *The Provincial Highway Designation Regulations*. Title

- 2 In these regulations, "official highway map" means the map contained in the Appendix. Interpretation.

- 3 Subject to section 4, the following public highways are designated as provincial highways: Provincial
highways
designated
 - (a) those public highways shown on the official highway map by distinctive lines in red colour representing "Divided", "Paved" or "Gravel" in accordance with the "Road Classification for Provincial Highways" contained in the official highway map;
 - (b) public highway No. 37 from its junction with Provincial Highway No. 1 at Gull Lake to its junction with Provincial Highway No. 332 at the north-west corner of Section 31, in Township 16, in Range 18, west of the Third Meridian and from Provincial Highway No. 332 at the south-east corner of Section 6, in Township 17, in Range 18, west of the Third Meridian to its junction with Provincial Highway No. 32 at Cabri; and

(c) public highway No. 317 extending from grid road No. 772 at the south-east corner of Section 15, in Township 31, in Range 27, west of the Third Meridian to its intersection with grid road No. 771 at the north-east corner of Section 8, in Township 35, in Range 27, west of the Third Meridian.

Exclusions **4** Any portion of a public highway lying or situated wholly within the boundaries of any municipal corporation having a population of 1,000 or more as determined by the 1981 Census of Canada or within the boundaries of the Prince Albert National Park is deemed not to be a provincial highway.

Repeal **5** Order in Council 483/83 is repealed.

Coming into force **6(1)** Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

(2) Clauses 3(b) and (c) of these regulations come into force on April 1, 1984.

- “(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of these regulations, the minimum amount of the sum of the basic, per capita and foundation grants paid to each urban municipality in the 1984-85 fiscal year is not to be less than the greater of:
- (a) the total amount to which that urban municipality was entitled under the equalization, per capita and police grant programs in the 1977-78 fiscal year; or
- (b) the total amount to which that urban municipality was entitled under the basic, per capita and foundation grants in the 1983-84 fiscal year”.
