- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Pests Declaration Regulations*. Title
- 2** The following are declared to be pests for the purposes of *The Pest Control Act*: Pests declared
- (a) the brown or Norway rat (*Rattus norvegicus* (Erxleben));
 - (b) Dutch Elm Disease (*Ceratocystis Ulmi*);
 - (c) grasshoppers; and
 - (d) the warble fly.
- 3** Saskatchewan Regulations 232/71 and 108/77 are repealed. Repeal
- 4** These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations. Coming into force
