CHAPTER D-7.1 REG 1

ORDER

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Advanced Education and Manpower, pursuant to clause 11(3)(b) of *The Department of Advanced Education and Manpower Act*, makes *The Advanced Education Institutions Fees Regulations* in accordance with the attached Schedule.

| | (a) "academic year" means a year commencing on July 1 in one year and ending on June 30 in the next year; | *academic year* |

- *educational institution* (g) "educational institution" means an educational institute established pursuant to section 11 of *The Department of Advanced Education and Manpower Act*;
- *post-diploma course* (h) "post-diploma course" means a course of instruction for which a diploma is a prerequisite;
- *semester* (i) "semester" means 20 weeks or less of course instruction;
- *withdrawal* (j) "withdrawal" means the voluntary departure of a student from an educational institution.

Fees **3** Subject to section 4, in the 1983-84 academic year, the fee payable in an educational institution:

- (a) for a diploma or post-diploma course, is \$195 per semester;
- (b) for a certificate course that is:
- (i) less than 38 weeks in duration, is \$29 for the first week and \$10 for each additional week; or
- (ii) 38 weeks or more in duration, is \$195 per semester;
- (c) where a student registered in a diploma or certificate course requires more time than the normal duration of the course as set out in the educational institution's calendar, is the amount set out in clause (b) plus an additional fee that is to be:
- (i) paid in advance;
- (ii) based on an estimated completion date as determined by the registrar of the educational institution; and
- (iii) assessed at a rate of \$10 per week of extra time required;
- (d) for a course of instruction offered through an extension division of an educational institution, is the amount identified by the educational institution as necessary to completely recover the estimated actual cost of offering the course;
- (e) for a course other than one described in clauses (a) to (d), is \$29 for the first week and \$10 for each additional week;
- (f) where permission is granted to audit a class offered as part of a course, is \$28 per semester;
- (g) for each set of three copies of a transcript of examination results, is \$3;
- (h) for each appeal of an examination paper, is \$13;
- (i) for challenge examinations, is an amount equal to the tuition fee for the period challenged and, in any event, is a minimum of \$29.

4 The fee set out in section 3 with respect to a diploma, post-diploma or certificate course is to be reduced by: Reductions

- (a) 75% for a person enrolled in no more than 25% of the classes that comprise the course;
- (b) 50% for a person enrolled in 26% to 50% of the classes that comprise the course; or
- (c) 25% for a person enrolled in 51% to 75% of the classes that comprise the course;

for the time period with respect to which the fee is paid and the calculation of the reduction is to be rounded to the nearest dollar.

5(1) Subject to the other provisions of this section, a fee prescribed in clause 3(a), (b) or (e) may be refunded, and the refund payable, where written notice of a student's withdrawal or discontinuation is received by the registrar of the educational institution: Refunds

- (a) no later than 14 days after the date on which the course of instruction begins, is 75% of the fee paid for the period of time during which the course of instruction, that has already commenced, is to be conducted;
- (b) more than 14 days but 30 days or less after the date on which the course of instruction begins, is 50% of the fee paid for the period of time during which the course of instruction, that has already been commenced, is to be conducted;
- (c) more than 30 days but 60 days or less after the date on which the course of instruction begins, is 25% of the fee paid for the period of time during which the course of instruction, that has already been commenced, is to be conducted;

together with 100% of any fee paid with respect to any subsequent period of time during which the course of instruction is to be held.

(2) No refunds are to be paid where withdrawal or discontinuation occurs:

- (a) more than 60 days after the date on which the course begins; or
- (b) during the last 75% of the program.

(3) Notwithstanding the fact that a refund may be payable under this section, the educational institution shall retain at least \$25 of the fee paid.

(4) Where a student who has paid a fee pursuant to clause 3(c) completes his training program in less than the estimated

time determined by the registrar pursuant to that clause, he may be paid a refund of \$10 for each full week not required.

(5) Where a student withdraws from or discontinues a course of instruction described in clause 3(d), he may be paid a refund:

(a) only if he withdraws or discontinues during the first 25% of the time period in respect of which he paid the fee; and

(b) of not more than 50% of the fee.

(6) The calculation of a refund or of any portion of a fee outstanding is to be rounded to the nearest dollar.

Fee for
damage, loss

6(1) An educational institution may charge any caution fees, replacement fees or other fees that may be necessary from time to time for articles of equipment or supplies which it considers to be lost or damaged.

(2) The fee for equipment that has been lost or damaged is an amount equal to the repair or replacement cost, as the case may be.

SCHEDULE

- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Wildlife Management Zones and Special Areas Boundaries Regulations*. Title
- 2(1)** Subject to subsection (2), the wildlife management zones described in Part I of the Appendix are constituted as areas for regulating, managing and controlling wildlife. Wildlife management zones
- (2)** Where any:
- (a) game preserve, wildlife management unit or wildlife refuge constituted by these regulations;
 - (b) protected area, provincial park or recreation site established in accordance with *The Provincial Parks, Protected Areas, Recreation Sites and Antiquities Act*; or
 - (c) regional park established pursuant to *The Regional Parks Act, 1979*;
- is contained within the boundaries of a wildlife management zone, it does not comprise a part of the wildlife management zone.
- 3** The wildlife management units described in Part II of the Appendix are constituted as areas for protecting, propagating, managing, harvesting, controlling or regulating wildlife and its habitat. Wildlife management units
- 4** The game preserves described in Part III of the Appendix are constituted as areas for protecting, propagating, managing, controlling, regulating or enhancing wildlife or wildlife habitat. Game preserves
- 5** The wildlife refuges described in Part IV of the Appendix are constituted as areas for protecting, perpetuating, managing, controlling or regulating a particular wildlife species and its habitat. Wildlife refuges
- 6** Order in Council 458/82 is repealed. Repeal
- 7** These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations. Coming into force

APPENDIX

PART I

Wildlife Management Zones

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 1

Wildlife Management Zone No. 1 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 2 between the south boundary of the province and Scout Lake;
- (b) the grid road and Highway No. 34 between Scout Lake and Bengough;
- (c) the grid road between Bengough and Ceylon;
- (d) Highways No. 377, No. 28, No. 18 and No. 35 between Ceylon and the south boundary of the province; and
- (e) the south boundary of the province between Highways No. 35 and No. 2.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 2

Wildlife Management Zone No. 2 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 37 and No. 18 between the south boundary of the province and Claydon;
- (b) the grid road and Highway No. 13 between Claydon and Shaunavon;
- (c) Highways No. 37 and No. 13 between Shaunavon and Kincaid;
- (d) Highways No. 19 and No. 18 between Kincaid and Wood Mountain;
- (e) the grid road between Wood Mountain and Scout Lake;
- (f) Highway No. 2 between Scout Lake and the south boundary of the province; and
- (g) the south boundary of the province between Highways No. 2 and No. 37.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 3

Wildlife Management Zone No. 3 is bounded by:

- (a) the west boundary of the province between the south boundary of the province and Highway No. 321;
- (b) Highway No. 321 between the west boundary of the province and Highway No. 21;
- (c) Highway No. 21 between Highway No. 321 and Highway No. 13;
- (d) Highway No. 13 between Highway No. 21 and the Claydon grid road junction;
- (e) the Claydon grid road between Highway No. 13 and Claydon;
- (f) Highways No. 18 and No. 37 between Claydon and the south boundary of the province; and
- (g) the south boundary of the province between Highway No. 37 and the west boundary of the province.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 4

Wildlife Management Zone No. 4 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 21 between Highways No. 13 and No. 1;
- (b) Highway No. 1 between Highways No. 21 and No. 37;
- (c) Highway No. 37 between Highways No. 1 and No. 13; and
- (d) Highway No. 13 between Highways No. 37 and No. 21.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 5

Wildlife Management Zone No. 5 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 21 between Highways No. 1 and No. 32;
- (b) Highway No. 32 between Highways No. 21 and No. 1; and
- (c) Highway No. 1 between Highways No. 32 and No. 21.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 6

Wildlife Management Zone No. 6 is bounded by:

- (a) the west boundary of the province between Highways No. 321 and No. 44;
- (b) Highway No. 44 between the west boundary of the province and Highway No. 42;
- (c) Highway No. 42 between Dinsmore and the first grid road junction west of Riverhurst;
- (d) the grid road from the junction west of Riverhurst southerly to Highway No. 1; and
- (e) Highways No. 1, No. 32, No. 21 and No. 321 between the grid road junction at Morse and the west boundary of the province.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 7

Wildlife Management Zone No. 7 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 35, No. 18, No. 28, No. 377 and No. 6 between the south boundary of the province and Highway No. 39;
- (b) Highway No. 39 between Highway No. 6 and Milestone;
- (c) the grid road running easterly between Milestone and Lewvan;
- (d) Highway No. 306 between Lewvan and Highway No. 35;
- (e) Highway No. 35 between Highway No. 306 and Highway No. 1;
- (f) Highway No. 1 between Highways No. 35 and No. 47;
- (g) Highways No. 47, No. 13 and No. 9 between Highway No. 1 and the south boundary of the province; and
- (h) the south boundary of the province between Highways No. 9 and No. 35.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 8

Wildlife Management Zone No. 8 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 37 between Highways No. 13 and No. 1;
- (b) Highway No. 1 between Highway No. 37 and the grid road junction at Parkbeg;
- (c) the grid road south from Parkbeg and Highway No. 363 between Highway No. 1 and Courval;
- (d) the south-east grid road between Courval and its junction with the Canadian National Railway line at Mossbank;
- (e) Highways No. 334 and No. 6 between Avonlea and Ceylon;
- (f) the grid road between Ceylon and Bengough;
- (g) Highway No. 34 and the grid road between Bengough and Wood Mountain; and
- (h) Highways No. 18, No. 19 and No. 13 between Wood Mountain and Highway No. 37.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 9

Wildlife Management Zone No. 9 is bounded by:

- (a) the first grid road west of Parkbeg between Highways No. 1 and No. 42;
- (b) Highway No. 42 between its junction with the second grid road west of Eyebrow and Keeler;
- (c) the grid road between Keeler and Highway No. 11 at Chamberlain;
- (d) Highways No. 11, No. 20 and No. 22 between Chamberlain and Highway No. 35;
- (e) Highways No. 35 and No. 10 between Highway No. 22 and Highway No. 306;
- (f) Highway No. 306 between Highway No. 35 and Lewvan;
- (g) the grid road between Highway No. 306 and Milestone;
- (h) Highways No. 39 and No. 334 between Milestone and Avonlea;
- (i) the Canadian National Railway line between Avonlea and Mossbank;
- (j) the north-east grid road between Mossbank and Courval;
- (k) Highway No. 363 and the grid road between Courval and its junction with Highway No. 1 at Parkbeg; and
- (l) Highway No. 1 between the grid road junction at Parkbeg and the first grid road junction west of Parkbeg.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 10

Wildlife Management Zone No. 10 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 20 and No. 16 between Highways No. 22 and No. 2;
- (b) Highways No. 2 and No. 5 between Highways No. 16 and No. 35; and
- (c) Highways No. 35 and No. 22 between Highways No. 5 and No. 20.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 11

Wildlife Management Zone No. 11 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 2 and No. 16 between Highways No. 11 and No. 20; and
- (b) Highways No. 20 and No. 11 between Highways No. 16 and No. 2.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 12

Wildlife Management Zone No. 12 is bounded by:

- (a) the grid road and Highway No. 42 between Morse and Dinsmore;
- (b) Highways No. 44 and No. 4 between Dinsmore and Highway No. 7;
- (c) Highways No. 7, No. 45 and No. 15 between Highways No. 4 and No. 2;
- (d) Highways No. 2 and No. 11 between Highway No. 15 and Chamberlain;
- (e) the grid road between Chamberlain and Keeler;
- (f) Highway No. 42 between Keeler and the first grid road junction west of Eyebrow;
- (g) the grid road between Highway No. 42 west of Eyebrow and Highway No. 1 west of Parkbeg; and
- (h) Highway No. 1 between the grid road junction west of Parkbeg and the grid road junction at Morse.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 13

Wildlife Management Zone No. 13 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 4 between Highway No. 7 and the Struan grid road junction;
- (b) the Struan grid road between Highways No. 4 and No. 376;
- (c) Highway No. 376 between Struan and Highway No. 16;
- (d) Highway No. 16 between Highways No. 376 and No. 340;
- (e) Highways No. 340 and No. 40 between Highway No. 16 and Highway No. 12;
- (f) Highways No. 12 and No. 312 between Highways No. 40 and No. 2;
- (g) Highways No. 2 and No. 15 between Highways No. 312 and No. 45; and
- (h) Highways No. 45 and No. 7 between Highways No. 15 and No. 4.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 14

Wildlife Management Zone No. 14 is bounded by:

- (a) the west boundary of the province between Highways No. 44 and No. 51;
- (b) Highways No. 51, No. 21, No. 31 and No. 4 between the west boundary of the province and Highway No. 44; and
- (c) Highway No. 44 between Highway No. 4 and the west boundary of the province.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 15

Wildlife Management Zone No. 15 is bounded by:

- (a) the west boundary of the province between Highways No. 51 and No. 14;
- (b) Highways No. 14 and No. 4 between the west boundary of the province and Highway No. 31; and
- (c) Highways No. 31, No. 21 and No. 51 between Highway No. 4 and the west boundary of the province.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 16

Wildlife Management Zone No. 16 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 9, No. 13 and No. 47 between the south boundary of the province and Highway No. 1;
- (b) Highway No. 1 between Highway No. 47 and the east boundary of the province;
- (c) the east boundary of the province between Highway No. 1 and the south boundary of the province; and
- (d) the south boundary of the province between the east boundary of the province and Highway No. 9.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 17

Wildlife Management Zone No. 17 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 35 and No. 10 between Highways No. 1 and No. 22;
- (b) Highways No. 22 and No. 9 between Highways No. 10 and No. 8;
- (c) Highways No. 8 and No. 16 between Highway No. 22 and the east boundary of the province;
- (d) the east boundary of the province between Highways No. 16 and No. 1; and
- (e) Highway No. 1 between the east boundary of the province and Highway No. 35.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 18

Wildlife Management Zone No. 18 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 9 and No. 49 between Highway No. 22 and the east boundary of the province;
- (b) the east boundary of the province between Highways No. 49 and No. 16; and
- (c) Highways No. 16, No. 8 and No. 22 between the east boundary of the province and Highway No. 9.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 19

Wildlife Management Zone No. 19 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 35 and No. 49 between Highways No. 10 and No. 9; and
- (b) Highways No. 9, No. 22 and No. 10 between Highways No. 49 and No. 35.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 20

Wildlife Management Zone No. 20 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 6 between Highway No. 5 and the south bank of the Saskatchewan River;
- (b) the south bank of the Saskatchewan River between Highways No. 6 and No. 35;

- (c) Highways No. 35, No. 55 and No. 23 between the south bank of the Saskatchewan River and Chelan;
- (d) the Chelan/McKague grid road between Chelan and Pre-Ste-Marie;
- (e) the Marean Lake grid road between Pre-Ste-Marie and Nobleville;
- (f) the Archerwill grid road between Nobleville and Highway No. 38; and
- (g) Highways No. 38, No. 49, No. 35 and No. 5 between the Archerwill grid road junction with Highway No. 38 and Highway No. 6.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 21

Wildlife Management Zone No. 21 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 2, No. 312 and No. 12 between Highways No. 5 and No. 40;
- (b) Highways No. 40, No. 3 and No. 2 between Highways No. 12 and No. 355;
- (c) Highways No. 355, No. 55 and No. 35 between Highway No. 2 and the south bank of the Saskatchewan River;
- (d) the south bank of the Saskatchewan River between Highways No. 35 and No. 6; and
- (e) Highways No. 6 and No. 5 between the south bank of the Saskatchewan River and Highway No. 2.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 22

Wildlife Management Zone No. 22 is bounded by:

- (a) the west boundary of the province between Highway No. 14 and the south bank of the North Saskatchewan River;
- (b) the south bank of the North Saskatchewan River between the west boundary of the province and Highway No. 3;
- (c) Highway No. 3 between the south bank of the North Saskatchewan River and Highway No. 40;
- (d) Highways No. 40, No. 340, No. 16 and No. 376 between Highway No. 3 and Struan;
- (e) the grid road west between Struan and Highway No. 4;
- (f) Highway No. 4 south between the Struan grid road and Highway No. 14; and
- (g) Highway No. 14 between Highway No. 4 and the west boundary of the province.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 23

Wildlife Management Zone No. 23 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 38 between Highway No. 49 and the Archerwill grid road junction with Highway No. 38;
- (b) the Archerwill grid road running westerly between Highway No. 38 and the Bjorkdale grid road junction;
- (c) the Bjorkdale grid road running northerly between the Archerwill grid road and the Chelan/McKague grid road;
- (d) the Chelan/McKague grid road running easterly between the Bjorkdale grid road junction and Chelan;
- (e) Highways No. 23 and No. 3 between Chelan and the east boundary of the province;
- (f) the east boundary of the province between Highways No. 3 and No. 49; and
- (g) Highways No. 49 and No. 38 between the east boundary of the province and the Archerwill grid road junction with Highway No. 38.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 24

Wildlife Management Zone No. 24 is bounded by:

- (a) the Fir River Road between Highways No. 3 and No. 163;
- (b) Highways No. 163 and No. 9 between the Fir River Road and the east boundary of the province;
- (c) the east boundary of the province between Highways No. 9 and No. 3; and
- (d) Highway No. 3 between the east boundary of the province and the Fir River Road.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 25

Wildlife Management Zone No. 25 is bounded by:

- (a) Highways No. 23 and No. 163 between Highway No. 3 and the Fir River Road;
- (b) the Fir River Road between Highways No. 163 and No. 3; and
- (c) Highway No. 3 between the Fir River Road and Highway No. 23.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 26

Wildlife Management Zone No. 26 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 123 between Highway No. 163 and the road to the Squaw Rapids hydro dam;
- (b) the Squaw Rapids hydro dam road between Highway No. 123 and the south bank of the Saskatchewan River;
- (c) the south bank of the Saskatchewan River (south channel) between the Squaw Rapids hydro dam and the east boundary of the province;
- (d) the east boundary of the province between the south bank of the Saskatchewan River and Highway No. 9; and
- (e) Highways No. 9 and No. 163 between the east boundary of the province and Highway No. 123.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 27

Wildlife Management Zone No. 27 is bounded by:

- (a) the 104° west longitude line between the Township 54 base line and the 54° 26' north latitude line;
- (b) the 54° 26' north latitude line between the 104° west longitude line and the south-west bank of the Sturgeon-Weir River;
- (c) the south-west bank of the Sturgeon-Weir River between the 54° 26' north latitude line and the Goose River;
- (d) the south bank of the Goose River between the Sturgeon-Weir River and the east boundary of the province;
- (e) the east boundary of the province between the Goose River and the Saskatchewan River (south channel); and
- (f) the south bank of the Saskatchewan River (south channel), the shore of Tobin Lake and the Township 54 base line between the east boundary of the province and the 104° west longitude line.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 28

Wildlife Management Zone No. 28 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 263 and the eastern Prince Albert National Park boundary between Highway No. 355 and the Township 61 base line;
- (b) the Township 61 baseline between the east boundary of the Prince Albert National Park and the 104° west longitude line;

- (c) the 104° west longitude line between the Township 61 base line and the Township 54 base line;
- (d) the Township 54 base line, the shore line of Tobin Lake, the Squaw Rapids hydro dam road and Highway No. 123 between the 104° west longitude line and Highway No. 23; and
- (e) Highways No. 23, No. 35, No. 55 and No. 355 between Highways No. 123 and No. 2.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 29

Wildlife Management Zone No. 29 is bounded by:

- (a) Highway No. 2, the Besnard Lake road and the Township 69 base line between the Township 61 base line and the 107° west longitude line;
- (b) the 107° west longitude line, the Township 73 base line between the Township 69 base line and Highway No. 102;
- (c) Highways No. 102, No. 2 and the 55° north latitude line between the Township 73 base line and the 104° west longitude line; and
- (d) the 104° west longitude line and the Township 61 base line between the 55° north latitude line and Highway No. 2.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ZONE NO. 30

Wildlife Management Zone No. 30 is bounded by;

- (a) Highways No. 4 and No. 55 between Highway No. 3 and the Township 57 base line;

 - (ii) those portions of Townships 40 and 41, in Range 1 lying east of the Swan River;
- and includes the road rights-of-way plus all lands within 400 metres of the centre line of the Tennant Lake Road, and the Woody Lake road from the junction of the Tennant Lake Road to the north boundary of Township 38.

BACKES ISLAND WILDLIFE REFUGE

Backes Island Wildlife Refuge consists of Backes Island located in Primrose Lake at 54° 58' N, 109° 43' W.

FAIRY ISLAND WILDLIFE REFUGE

FISHING LAKE WILDLIFE REFUGE

(d) in the case of a loan renewable in a term of more than five years, the Farm Credit Corporation lending rate in force during the month the loan is obtained.

“(4) Where a loan obtained on or after September 1, 1983 is renewed, the base rate for that loan is the base rate for that type of loan prescribed in subsection (3) that is in force on the date the loan was renewed.

“(5) Where a participant obtained a loan on or after July 1, 1983 and before September 1, 1983, he may elect at any time before his loan is approved or at the time he renews the loan, by notifying the minister in writing, to have the base rate for his loan calculated under subsection (3) and, where he so elects, his loan is deemed, for the purpose of calculating the base rate, to have been obtained on or after September 1, 1983”.

(a) during the first five year period after the loan is obtained, the difference between:

(i) an amount equal to the principal and interest payment of the participant's loan calculated using the amount and the amortization period of the participant's eligible loan and an annual interest rate equal to the base rate prescribed in subsection 8(3) that is in force:

(A) on the date that the loan is obtained; or

(B) where the loan has been renewed, on the date the loan was last renewed; and

(ii) an amount equal to the principal and interest payment on the participant's loan calculated using the amount and the amortization period of the participant's eligible loan and an annual interest rate equal to the guaranteed rate; and

(b) during the second five year period after the loan is obtained, the difference between:

(i) an amount equal to the principal and interest payment on the participant's loan calculated using the amount and the amortization period of the participant's eligible loan and an annual interest rate equal to the base rate prescribed in subsection 8(3) that is in force:

(A) five years after the date the loan is obtained; or

(B) where the loan has been renewed, on the date the loan was last renewed; and

(ii) an amount equal to the principal and interest payment on the participant's loan calculated using the amount and the amortization period of the participant's eligible loan and an annual interest rate equal to the guaranteed rate".
