CHAPTER 1

An Act respecting Certain Elections in the Constituencies of
The Battlefords, Estevan and Kelsey-Tisdale

(Assented to November 28, 1980)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Battlefords, Estevan and Kelsey-Tisdale Constituencies Election Act*.

John Otho Chapman deemed elected

2 Notwithstanding anything in any other Act, with respect to the election held in the constituency of Estevan on November 26, 1980, for the purpose of electing a member of the Legislative Assembly, it is deemed that:

- (a) the Chief Electoral Officer has received from the returning officer a return under section 143 of *The Election Act* showing that John Otho Chapman has been duly elected;
- (b) the Chief Electoral Officer has, under section 146 of *The Election Act*, published a notice in the Gazette showing the name of the said John Otho Chapman as the candidate elected at the said election; and
- (c) the said John Otho Chapman has been duly elected at the said election.

Neal Hebert Hardy deemed elected

3 Notwithstanding anything in any other Act, with respect to the election held in the constituency of Kelsey-Tisdale on November 26, 1980, for the purpose of electing a member of the Legislative Assembly, it is deemed that:

- (a) the Chief Electoral Officer has received from the returning officer a return under section 143 of *The Election Act* showing that Neal Hebert Hardy has been duly elected;
- (b) the Chief Electoral Officer, has under section 146 of *The Election Act*, published a notice in the Gazette showing the name of the said Neal Hebert Hardy as the candidate elected at the said election; and
- (c) the said Neal Hebert Hardy has been duly elected at the said election.

David Manly Miner deemed elected

4 Notwithstanding anything in any other Act, with respect to the election held in the constituency of The Battlefords on November 26, 1980, for the purpose of electing a member of the Legislative Assembly, it is deemed that:

- (a) the Chief Electoral Officer has received from the returning officer a return under section 143 of *The Election Act* showing that David Manly Miner has been duly elected;

- (b) the Chief Electoral Officer has, under section 146 of *The Election Act*, published a notice in the Gazette showing the name of the said David Manly Miner as the candidate elected at the said election; and
- (c) the said David Manly Miner has been duly elected at the said election.

Duties respecting election to be performed; powers and privileges under law preserved

5(1) All things and proceedings that are required by *The Election Act* or *The Controverted Elections Act* or any other Act to be done or taken in respect of the said elections are to be done or taken in the same manner as they would have been done or taken, and when done or taken have the same effect as they would have had, if this Act had not been passed.

(2) All things and proceedings that may, under *The Election Act* or *The Controverted Elections Act* or any other Act, be done or taken in respect of the said elections may be done or taken in the same manner as they might have been done or taken, and when done or taken have the same effect as they would have had, if this Act had not been passed.

(3) If, after all such things or proceedings have been done or taken, or the time within which any thing or proceeding may be done or taken has expired, it appears that the said John Otho Chapman was not duly elected, section 2 is deemed to have been repealed and thereupon he ceases to be a member of the Legislative Assembly.

(4) If, after all such things or proceedings have been done or taken, or the time within which any thing or proceeding may be done or taken has expired, it appears that the said Neal Hebert Hardy was not duly elected, section 3 is deemed to have been repealed and thereupon he ceases to be a member of the Legislative Assembly.

(5) If, after all such things or proceedings have been done or taken, or the time within which any thing or proceeding may be done or taken has expired, it appears that the said David Manly Miner was not duly elected, section 4 is deemed to have been repealed and thereupon he ceases to be a member of the Legislative Assembly.
