**CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 140**  
*The Government Organization Act*

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure Regulations, 2007*.

**Ministry continued**

**2** The department of the Government of Saskatchewan called the Department of Highways and Transportation is continued as the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure.

**Objects and purposes**

**3** The objects and purposes of the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure are the following:

- (a) to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister of Highways and Infrastructure may be exercised and carried out;
- (b) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to transportation services and facilities;
- (c) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to:
  - (i) water, sewage and other infrastructure and facilities of municipalities; and
  - (ii) the infrastructure program of the Government of Canada;
- (d) to collect, assimilate and publish information concerning matters relating to transportation;
- (e) to provide information to municipalities respecting the planning, design, construction, improvement and maintenance of public highways;
- (f) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to roads, bridges, ferries and general transportation in or affecting municipalities.
