CHAPTER R-20.2

An Act respecting Representation in the Legislative Assembly

(Assented to August 25, 1989)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title1 This Act may be cited as The Representation Act, 1989.

Composition of Assembly

2 Notwithstanding section 13 of The Electoral Boundaries Commission Act, the Legislative Assembly shall consist of 66 members to be elected to represent the constituencies described in the Schedule to this Act.

3 The Representation Act, 1981 is repealed.

Coming into force4 This Act comes into force on the day following the day on which the twenty-first Legislative Assembly is dissolved or is determined by effluxion of time.

SCHEDULE

Interpretation of Constituency Descriptions

Boundaries of constituencies

1 In the following descriptions where "meridians" and "boundaries of townships" or "boundaries of sections" are referred to as the boundaries of constituencies, these expressions mean the meridians, boundaries of townships or boundaries of sections, as the case may be, in accordance with the Saskatchewan land system of surveys and include the extensions thereof in accordance with that system.

Dividing line

2 Where a dividing line between two ranges is mentioned as the boundary of a constituency, the expression means the surveyed line on the east boundary of the west range and the extension of that line southerly to intersect the north boundary of each township that lies to the south of a correction line and thence easterly along the north boundary of such township to the east boundary of such township.

North boundary

3 Where the north boundary of a township is mentioned as the boundary of a constituency and a jog exists between the north boundaries of a township on either side of a dividing line, the expression means that the boundary of the constituency follows along the portion of

the dividing line that extends between the respective north boundaries of the township.

Section boundaries

- 4 Where boundaries of sections are mentioned as the boundary of a constituency and a correction line or jog exists between two section boundaries described, the expression means that the boundary of the constituency follows along the portion of the north boundary of a township or dividing line that extends between the respective section boundaries described.

Left bank boundary

- 5 Where the left bank of any stream or lake is mentioned as the boundary of a constituency, the expression means the bank of that stream or lake on the left side of a person going in the direction in which the water flows.

References as defined in The Land Surveys Act

- 6 Where in the following descriptions reference is made to "meridian", "township" or "range" and the meridian, township or range lies outside the portion of the province subdivided in accordance with the provisions of The Land Surveys Act, the reference is taken to be in accordance with the projection of the meridian, township or range as defined in the Act.

Inclusion of hamlet, village or town cut by constituency boundary

- 7 When a constituency boundary cuts through a hamlet, village or town, and that hamlet, village or town has not been specifically mentioned in the constituency description, the boundary is to include the area of lesser population as lying within the constituency in which the part with the greater population lies.

References to limits of village, town or city

- 8 Where reference in descriptions of boundaries is made to limits or incorporated limits of any village, town or city, the reference means those limits as defined as of July 1, 1988.

ARM RIVER

The constituency of Arm River is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 30 with the dividing line between Ranges 25 and 26, West of the Second Meridian; thence westerly along the

north boundary of Township 30 to the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the Third Meridian to the north boundary of Township 34; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 34 to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence southerly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River and continuing south along the west limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker to the north boundary of Township 24; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 24 to the east limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker; thence south-easterly and southerly along the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker to the centre line of the conduit outlet on the south end of the Qu'Appelle Dam; thence south-easterly along the said centre line of the conduit outlet and the centre line of the canal between the Qu'Appelle Dam and the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River and the north-eastern bank of Eyebrow Lake and Buffalo Pound Lake, respectively, to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 26 and 27, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 26 and 27 to the north boundary of Township 21, thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 21 to the intersection with the east bank of Last Mountain Lake; thence northerly along the east bank of Last Mountain Lake to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 23 and 24, in Township 28, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 23 and 24 to the north boundary of Township 29; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 29 to the dividing line between Ranges 25 and 26, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 25 and 26 to the point of commencement.

ASSINIBOIA-GRAVELBOURG

The constituency of Assiniboia-Gravelbourg is bounded as follows:
Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6 to the north boundary of Township 9; thence westerly along said north boundary to the dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7 to the north boundary of Township 12; thence easterly along the said north boundary of Township 12 to the dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28 to the north boundary of Township 10; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 10 to the north-east corner of Section 34 in the said Township 10; thence southerly along the east boundary of the said Section 34 and its production southerly to the east bank of Lake of the Rivers; thence continuing southerly along the said east bank of Lake of the Rivers to the north boundary of Township 9; thence easterly along the said north boundary of Township 9 to the dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28 to the intersection with the south bank of Willow Bunch Lake; thence south-easterly and northerly along the south bank of Willow Bunch Lake to the intersection with the north boundary of Section 9, in Township 5, in Range 25; thence easterly along the north boundary of Sections 9, 10, 11 and 12 in the said Township 5

to the dividing line between Ranges 24 and 25; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 24 and 25 to the south boundary of the province; thence westerly along the said south boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

ATHABASCA

The constituency of Athabasca is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Meadow Lake Provincial Park with the west boundary of the province; thence northerly along the west boundary of the province to the north boundary of the province; thence easterly along the north boundary of the province to the Meridian through the 105° of west longitude; thence southerly along the said Meridian of longitude to the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude; thence westerly along the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude to the Third Meridian; thence southerly along the Third Meridian to the north boundary of Prince Albert National Park; thence westerly and southerly along the north and west boundaries of Prince Albert National Park to the north boundary of Township 60; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 60 to the dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14 to the north boundary of Township 64; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 64 to the intersection with the east boundary of Meadow Lake Provincial Park thence northerly and westerly along the east and north boundaries of Meadow Lake Provincial Park to the point of commencement.

BENGOUGH-MILESTONE

The constituency of Bengough-Milestone is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between Ranges 24 and 25, West of the Second Meridian; thence easterly along the said south boundary of the province to the dividing line between Ranges 12 and 13; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 12 and 13 to the north boundary of Township 6; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 6 to the dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16 to the north boundary of Township 12; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 12 to the dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28 to the north boundary of Township 10; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 10 to the north-east corner of Section 34, in said Township 10; thence southerly along the east boundary of the said Section 34 and its production southerly to the east bank of Lake of the Rivers; thence continuing southerly along the said east bank of Lake of the Rivers to the north boundary of Township 9; thence easterly along the said north boundary of Township 9 to the dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 27 and 28 to the intersection with the south bank of Willow Bunch Lake; thence south-easterly and northerly along the south bank of Willow Bunch Lake to the intersection with the north boundary of Section 9, in Township 5, in Range 25; thence easterly along the

north boundary of Sections 9, 10, 11 and 12 in the said Township 5 to the dividing line between Ranges 24 and 25; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 24 and 25 to the point of commencement.

BIGGAR

The constituency of Biggar is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River with the north boundary of Township 30; thence north-easterly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the south limit of the incorporated area of the City of Saskatoon; thence northerly and westerly and easterly along the south, west, north and east limits of the incorporated area of the City of Saskatoon to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence northerly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the east boundary of Township 37, in Range 5, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the east boundary of the said Township 37 to the north boundary of the said Township 37; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 37, in Ranges 5, 6 and 7 to the dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8 to the intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence westerly and north-westerly along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the north boundary of Township 42; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 42 to the dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19, West of the Third Meridian, thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19 to the north boundary of Township 39; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 39 to the dividing line between Ranges 17 and 18, West of the Third Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 17 and 18 to the north boundary of Township 36; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 36 to the intersection with the east bank of Tramping Lake; thence southerly along the east bank of Tramping Lake to the intersection with the east boundary of Section 33, in Township 34, in Range 20, West of the Third Meridian; thence southerly along the east boundary of Sections 33, 28, 21, 16 and 4, in Township 34, in Range 20, West of the Third Meridian to the north boundary of Township 33; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 33 to the dividing line between Ranges 12 and 13, West of the Third Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 12 and 13 to the north boundary of Township 30; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 30 to the point of commencement.

CANORA

The constituency of Canora is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 38 with the dividing line between Ranges 3 and 4, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 3 and 4 to the north boundary of Township 26; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 26 to the dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing

line between Ranges 5 and 6 to the north boundary of Township 24; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 24 to the dividing line between Ranges 8 and 9, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 8 and 9 to the north boundary of Township 33; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 33 to the dividing line between Ranges 9 and 10, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 9 and 10 to the north boundary of Township 38; thence easterly along the said north boundary of Township 38 to the point of commencement; and adding thereto that part of the incorporated area of the Town of Canora lying east of the dividing line between Ranges 3 and 4, West of the Second Meridian.

CUMBERLAND

The constituency of Cumberland is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 54 with the east boundary of the province; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 54 to the dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8 to the intersection with the left bank of the Saskatchewan River; thence westerly along the left bank of the Saskatchewan River to the north limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Tobin Lake; thence westerly along the north limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Tobin Lake to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 11 and 12, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 11 and 12 to the north boundary of Township 55; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 55 to the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22 to the north boundary of Township 57; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 57 to the intersection with the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the Third Meridian to the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude; thence easterly along the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude to the Meridian through the 105° of west longitude; thence northerly along the said Meridian of longitude to the north boundary of the province; thence easterly along the north boundary of the province to the east boundary of the province; thence southerly along the east boundary of the province to the point of commencement; and including therein that part of the Little Red River Indian Reserve No. 106 lying south of the north boundary of Township 57.

CUT KNIFE-LLOYDMINSTER

The constituency of Cut Knife-Lloydminster is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 42 with the west boundary of the province; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 42 to the intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence north-westerly along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the west boundary of the province; thence southerly along the west boundary of the

province to the point of commencement; excepting thereout and therefrom that part of the constituency hereinafter described as The Battlefords lying south and west of the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River.

ESTEVAN

The constituency of Estevan is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between Ranges 12 and 13, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 12 and 13 to the north boundary of Township 6; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 6 to the dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6 to the north boundary of Township 3; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 3 to the dividing line between Ranges 4 and 5, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 4 and 5 to the south boundary of the province; thence westerly along the south boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

HUMBOLDT

The constituency of Humboldt is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 30 with the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the Third Meridian to the north boundary of Township 34; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 34 to the intersection of the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence northerly along the said left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the south limit of the corporate limits of the City of Saskatoon; thence northerly and easterly along the said corporate limits of the City of Saskatoon to the intersection with the production westerly of the south boundary of Highway No. 5; thence easterly along the said production and continuing easterly along the south boundary of the said Highway No. 5 to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 1 and 2, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 1 and 2 to the north boundary of Township 38; thence easterly along the said north boundary of Township 38 to the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22 to the north boundary of Township 33; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 33 to the dividing line between Ranges 22 and 23, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 22 and 23 to the north boundary of Township 29; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 29 to the dividing line between Ranges 25 and 26, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 25 and 26 to the north boundary of Township 30; thence westerly along the said north boundary of Township 30 to the point of commencement; and excepting thereout and therefrom that part of the incorporated area of the Town of Vonda, lying to the south of the north boundary of Township 38.

INDIAN HEAD-WOLSELEY

The constituency of Indian Head-Wolseley is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 12 with the dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16 to the north boundary of Township 16; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 16 to the dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14 to the north boundary of Township 19; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 19 to the intersection with the north-east bank of Katepwa Lake; thence south-easterly along the north-east bank of Katepwa Lake and the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River and the north banks of Crooked Lake and Round Lake to the east boundary of the Ochapowace Indian Reserve No. 71; thence southerly and westerly along the east and south boundaries of the Ochapowace Indian Reserve No. 71 to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 3 and 4, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 3 and 4 to the north boundary of Township 14; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 14 to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7 to the north boundary of Township 12; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 12 to the point of commencement.

KELSEY-TISDALE

The constituency of Kelsey-Tisdale is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 39 with the east boundary of the province; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 39 to the dividing line between Ranges 3 and 4; thence southerly along the said dividing line to the north boundary of Township 38; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 38 to the dividing line between Ranges 9 and 10; thence northerly along the said dividing line to the north boundary of Township 39; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 39 to the intersection with the east boundary of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90; thence northerly and westerly and southerly along the east, north and west boundary of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90 to the intersection with the north bank of Nut Lake; thence westerly and southerly along the north and west banks of Nut Lake to the north boundary of Township 38; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 38 to the dividing line between Ranges 14 and 15, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 14 and 15 to the north boundary of Township 39; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 39 to the dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16 to the north boundary of Township 45; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 45 to the dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8 to the north boundary of Township

48; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 48 to the dividing line between Ranges 2 and 3, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 2 and 3 to the north boundary of Township 52; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 52 to the east boundary of the province; thence southerly along the east boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

KELVINGTON-WADENA

The constituency of Kelvington-Wadena is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 25 with the dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14 to the north boundary of Township 27; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 27 to the dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16 to the intersection with the south bank of Little Quill Lake; thence easterly along the south bank of Little Quill Lake to the dividing line between Ranges 14 and 15, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 14 and 15 to the north boundary of Township 38; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 38 to the intersection with the west bank of Nut Lake; thence northerly along the west bank of Nut Lake to the intersection with the west boundary of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90; thence northerly and easterly and southerly along the west and north and east boundaries of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90 to the north boundary of Township 39; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 39 to the dividing line between Ranges 9 and 10, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 9 and 10 to the north boundary of Township 33; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 33 to the dividing line between Ranges 8 and 9, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 8 and 9 to the north boundary of Township 25; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 25 to the point of commencement.

KINDERSLEY

The constituency of Kindersley is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 33 with the west boundary of the province; thence southerly along the west boundary of the province to the intersection with the left bank of the Red Deer River; thence easterly along the left bank of the Red Deer River to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence easterly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19 to the north boundary of Township 24; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 24 to the dividing line between Ranges 17 and 18, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 17 and 18 to the north boundary of Township 27; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 27 to the dividing

line between Ranges 18 and 19, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19 to the north boundary of Township 33; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 33 to the point of commencement.

KINISTINO

The constituency of Kinistino is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 38 with the dividing line between Ranges 1 and 2, West of the Third Meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 38 to the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22 to the north boundary of Township 39; thence easterly along the said north boundary of Township 39 to the east boundary of Section 6, in Township 40, in Range 21, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the east boundaries of Sections 6, 7 and 18, easterly along the south boundaries of Sections 20 and 21, northerly along the east boundaries of Sections 21, 28, 33 and westerly along the north boundary of Section 33, all in Township 40, in Range 21, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the east boundaries of Sections 5, 8 and 17; westerly along the north boundary of Section 17, northerly along the east boundary of Section 19 and westerly along the north boundary of Section 19, all in Township 41, in Range 21, West of the Second Meridian, to the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22 to the north boundary of Section 18, in Township 45, in Range 21, West of the Second Meridian; thence easterly along the north boundaries of Sections 18, 17, 16, 15, 14 and 13, in Township 45, in Range 21, West of the Second Meridian, and continuing easterly along the north boundary of Township 45 to the dividing line between Ranges 20 and 21, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 20 and 21 to the intersection with the left bank of the Saskatchewan River; thence north-westerly along the left bank of the Saskatchewan River and continuing westerly along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the east boundary of the corporate limits of the City of Prince Albert; thence south and west along the said corporate limits of the City of Prince Albert to the intersection with the west limit of Highway No. 2; thence southerly along Highway No. 2 to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence south-westerly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the north-east boundary of the corporate limits of the City of Saskatoon; thence southerly and easterly along the said corporate limits of the City of Saskatoon to the intersection with the production westerly of the south boundary of Highway No. 5; thence easterly along the said production and continuing easterly along the south boundary of the said Highway No. 5 to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 1 and 2, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 1 and 2, to the point of commencement; and including therein that part of the Town of Vonda lying south of the north boundary of Township 38.

LAST MOUNTAIN-TOUCHWOOD

The constituency of Last Mountain-Touchwood is bounded as follows:

The constituency of Souris-Cannington is bounded as follows:
Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between Ranges 4 and 5, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 4 and 5 to the north boundary of Township 3; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 3 to the dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6 to the north boundary of Township 6; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 6 to the dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7 to the north boundary of Township 9; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 9 to the intersection with the west boundary of Moose Mountain Provincial Park; thence southerly and easterly along the west and south boundaries of Moose Mountain Provincial Park to the intersection with the west boundary of the White Bear Indian Reserve No. 70; thence northerly, easterly and southerly along the west, north and east boundaries of the White Bear Indian Reserve No. 70 to the intersection with the north boundary of Township 9; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 9 to the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the Second Meridian to the north boundary of Township 8; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 8 to the intersection with the east boundary of the province; thence southerly along the east boundary of the province to the south boundary of the province; thence westerly along the south boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

SWIFT CURRENT

The constituency of Swift Current comprises the area lying within the boundaries of the incorporated area of the City of Swift Current.

THE BATTLEFORDS

The constituency of The Battlefords comprises the area lying within the corporate limits of the Town of Battleford and the corporate limits of the City of North

Battleford and includes that part of Section 28, in Township 43, in Range 16, West of the Third Meridian, lying northerly and easterly of the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River, and southerly and westerly of the south and west corporate limits of the City of North Battleford.

THUNDER CREEK

The constituency of Thunder Creek is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 12 with the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22, West of the Second Meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 12 to the dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7 to the north boundary of Township 19; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 19 to the dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 7 and 8 to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; and continuing south along the west limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker; thence northerly and easterly along the said full supply line and the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the north boundary of Township 24; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 24 to the east limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker; thence south-easterly and southerly along the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker to the centre line of the conduit outlet on the south end of the Qu'Appelle Dam; thence south-easterly along the said centre line of the conduit outlet and the centre line of the canal between the Qu'Appelle Valley to the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River; thence south-easterly along the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River and the north-east bank of Eyebrow Lake and Buffalo Pound Lake respectively to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 26 and 27, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 26 and 27 to the north boundary of Township 21; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 21 to the intersection with the north-east bank of Last Mountain Lake; thence south-easterly along the north-east bank of Last Mountain Lake to the intersection with the dividing line between Ranges 22 and 23, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 22 and 23 to the north boundary of Township 18; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 18 to the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22 to the point of commencement; excepting thereout and therefrom the constituencies hereinbefore described as Moose Jaw Wakamow and Moose Jaw Hillcrest.

TURTLEFORD

The constituency of Turtleford is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River with the east boundary of Section 8, in Township 51, in Range 23, West of the Third Meridian; thence south-easterly along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to

the intersection with the north boundary of Township 47, in Range 20, West of the Third Meridian; thence easterly along the said north boundary to the dividing line between Ranges 19 and 20; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 19 and 20 to the north-east corner of Section 24, in Township 48; thence easterly along the north boundary of Sections 19 to 24, inclusive, in Township 48, in Range 19 to the dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19 to the north boundary of Township 48; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 48 to the intersection with the west boundary of the Mistawasis Indian Reserve No. 103; thence northerly and easterly along the west and north boundaries of the Mistawasis Indian Reserve No. 103 to the dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6 to the intersection with the left bank of the Shell River; thence north-westerly along the left bank of the Shell River to the intersection with the south boundary of the Sandy Lake Indian Reserve No. 104; thence easterly and northerly along the south and east boundaries of the Sandy Lake Indian Reserve No. 104 to the north boundary of Section 25, in Township 51, in Range 6, West of the Third Meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of the said Section 25 to the dividing line between Ranges 5 and 6, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the dividing line between the said Ranges 5 and 6 to the intersection with the west boundary of Prince Albert National Park; thence northerly along the west boundary of Prince Albert National Park to the north boundary of Township 60; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 60 to the dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14, West of the Third Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 13 and 14 to the north-east corner of Section 12, in Township 60, in Range 14; thence westerly along the north boundary of Sections 12, 11, 10, 9, 8 and 7, in Township 60, in Range 14 to the dividing line between Ranges 14 and 15; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 14 and 15 to the north boundary of Township 54; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 54 to the dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 21 and 22 to the north-east corner in Section 12, in Township 52, in Range 22, West of the Third Meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of Sections 12, 11, 10, 9, 8 and 7, in the said Township and continuing westerly along the north boundary of Sections 12, 11, 10 and 9 to the north-east corner of Section 8, in Township 52, in Range 23; thence southerly along the east boundaries of Sections 8 and 5 in Township 52, and the east boundaries of Sections 32, 29, 20, 17 and 8, in Township 51 to the point of commencement.

WEYBURN

The constituency of Weyburn is bounded as follows:
Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Township 6 with the dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16, West of the Second Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 15 and 16 to the north boundary of Township 12; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 12 to the dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7, West of the Second Meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 6 and 7 to the north boundary of Township 6; thence westerly along

the north boundary of Township 6 to the point of commencement.

WILKIE

The constituency of Wilkie is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the west boundary of the province with the north boundary of Township 33; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 33 to the east boundary of Section 4, in Township 34, in Range 20, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the east boundaries of Sections 4, 9, 16, 21, 28 and 33, in Township 34, in Range 20, West of the Third Meridian to the east bank of Tramping Lake; thence northerly along the east bank of Tramping Lake to the north boundary of Township 36; thence easterly along the north boundary of Township 36 to the dividing line between Ranges 17 and 18, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 17 and 18 to the north boundary of Township 39; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 39 to the dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19, West of the Third Meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between Ranges 18 and 19 to the north boundary of Township 42; thence westerly along the north boundary of Township 42 to the west boundary of the province; thence southerly along the west boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

YORKTON

The constituency of Yorkton comprises the area lying within the corporate limits of the City of Yorkton.
