## CHAPTER R-20

### An Act respecting Representation in the Legislative Assembly.

#### Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Representation Act*.

#### Composition of Assembly

2 The Legislative Assembly shall consist of sixty-one members to be elected to represent the constituencies defined in the schedule to this Act.

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#### SCHEDULE.

1. In the following descriptions where “**meridians**” and “**boundaries of townships**” or “**boundaries of sections**” are referred to as the boundaries of constituencies these expressions mean the meridians, boundaries of townships or boundaries of sections, as the case may be, in accordance with the Saskatchewan land system of surveys and include the extensions thereof in accordance with the said system.

2. Where a dividing line between two ranges is mentioned as the boundary of a constituency the expressions shall mean the surveyed line on the east boundary of the westerly range and the extension of such line southerly to intersect the north boundary of each township that lies to the south of a correction line and thence easterly along the north boundary of such township to the east boundary thereof.

3. Where the north boundary of a township is mentioned as the boundary of a constituency and a jog exists between the north boundaries of a township on either side of a dividing line the expression shall mean that the boundary of the constituency shall follow along the portion of the dividing line that extends between the respective north boundaries of the township.

4. Where boundaries of sections are mentioned as the boundary of a constituency and a correction line or jog exists between two section boundaries described, the expression shall mean that the boundary of the constituency shall follow along the portion of the north boundary of a township or dividing line that extends between the respective section boundaries described.

5. Where the left bank of any stream or lake is mentioned as the boundary of a constituency the expression shall mean the bank of such stream or lake on the left side of a person going in the direction in which the water flows.

6. Where descriptions of boundaries are given, they are those existing and registered on the thirtieth day of April, 1973.

7. When a constituency boundary cuts through a hamlet, village or town, and the said hamlet, village or town has not been specifically mentioned in the constituency description, the boundary shall be such as to include the area of lesser population as lying within the constituency in which the part with the greater population lies.

## ARM RIVER

The constituency of Arm River bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty with the dividing line between ranges twenty-five and twenty-six west of the second meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty to the third meridian; thence northerly along the third meridian to the north boundary of township thirty-three; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-three to the dividing line between ranges three and four west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges three and four to the north boundary of township thirty-four; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-four to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence southerly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the north boundary of township twenty-four; thence easterly along the north boundary of township twenty-four to the east limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker; thence south-easterly and southerly along the full supply level of the reservoir known as Lake Diefenbaker to the centre line of the conduit outlet on the southern end of the Qu'Appelle Valley dam; thence south-easterly along the said centre line of the conduit outlet and the centre line of the canal between the said Qu'Appelle Valley dam and the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River to the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River; thence south-easterly along the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River and the north-eastern banks of Eyebrow Lake and Buffalo Pound Lake respectively to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges twenty-six and twenty-seven west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-six and twenty-seven to the north boundary of township twenty-one; thence easterly along the north boundary of township twenty-one to the intersection with the easterly bank of Last Mountain Lake; thence northerly along the easterly bank of Last Mountain Lake to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges twenty-three and twenty-four in township twenty-eight west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-three and twenty-four to the north boundary of township twenty-nine; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-nine to the dividing line between ranges twenty-five and twenty-six west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-five and twenty-six to the point of commencement.

## ASSINIBOIA-GRAVELBOURG

The constituency of Assiniboia-Gravelbourg bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between ranges five and six west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges five and six to the north boundary of township nine; thence westerly along the north boundary of township nine to the dividing line between ranges six and seven west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges six and seven to the north boundary of township twelve; thence easterly along the north boundary of township twelve to the dividing line between ranges twenty-six and twenty-seven west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-six and twenty-seven to the north boundary of township six; thence easterly along the north boundary of township six to the dividing line between ranges twenty-four and twenty-five west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-four and twenty-five to the south boundary of the province; thence westerly along the south boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

## ATHABASCA

The constituency of Athabasca bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of Meadow Lake Provincial Park with the west boundary of the province; thence northerly along the west boundary of the province to the north boundary of the province; thence easterly along the north boundary of the province to the meridian through the one hundred and fifth degree of west longitude; thence southerly along the said meridian of longitude to the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude; thence westerly along the fifty-ninth parallel north latitude to the third meridian; thence southerly along the third meridian to the north boundary of Prince Albert National Park; thence westerly and southerly along the north and west boundaries of Prince Albert National Park to the north boundary of township sixty; thence westerly along the north boundary of township sixty to the dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen to the north boundary of township sixty-four; thence westerly along the north boundary of township sixty-four to the intersection with the east boundary of Meadow Lake Provincial Park; thence northerly and westerly along the east and north boundaries of Meadow Lake Provincial Park to the point of commencement.

## THE BATTLEFORDS

The constituency of The Battlefords comprising the area described as follows: All that part of township forty-three in range sixteen west of the third meridian, and township forty-three in range seventeen west of the third meridian, and township forty-four in range sixteen west of the third meridian, and township forty-four in range seventeen west of the third meridian, lying within the boundaries of the incorporated area of The Town of Battleford and The City of North Battleford.

## BENGOUGH-MILESTONE

The constituency of Bengough-Milestone bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between ranges twenty-four and twenty-five west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-four and twenty-five to the north boundary of township six; thence westerly along the north boundary of township six to the dividing line between ranges twenty-six and twenty-seven west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-six and twenty-seven to the north boundary of township twelve; thence easterly along the north boundary of township twelve to the dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen to the north boundary of township six; thence easterly along the north boundary of township six to the dividing line between ranges twelve and thirteen west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twelve and thirteen to the south boundary of the province; thence westerly along the south boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

## BIGGAR

The constituency of Biggar bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River with the north boundary of township thirty; thence north-easterly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the south limit of the incorporated area of The City of Saskatoon; thence westerly and northerly along the south and west limits of the incorporated area of The City of Saskatoon to the intersection with the north boundary of township thirty-six; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-six to the dividing line between ranges seven and eight west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges seven and eight to the intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence westerly and north westerly along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the north boundary of township forty-two; thence westerly along the north boundary of township forty-two to the dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen to the north boundary of township thirty-nine; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-nine to the dividing line between ranges seventeen and eighteen west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges seventeen and eighteen to the north boundary of township thirty-six; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-six to the intersection with the east bank of Tramping Lake; thence southerly along the east bank of Tramping Lake to the intersection with the east boundary of section thirty-three in township thirty-four in range twenty, west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the eastboundary of sections thirty-three, twenty-eight, twenty-one, six teen, nine and four in township thirty-four in range twenty west of the third meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-three to the dividing line between ranges twelve and thirteen west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twelve and thirteen to the north boundary of township thirty; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty to the point of commencement.

## CANORA

The constituency of Canora bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty-nine with the dividing line between ranges three and four west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges three and four to the north boundary of township twenty-six; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-six to the dividing line between ranges five and six west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges five and six to the north boundary of township twenty-four; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-four to the dividing line between ranges eight and nine west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges eight and nine to the north boundary of township thirty-three; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-three to the dividing line between ranges nine and ten west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges nine and ten to the north boundary of township thirty-nine; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-nine to the point of commencement; and adding thereto that part of the incorporated area of The Town of Canora lying to the east of the dividing line between ranges three and four west of the second meridian.

## CUMBERLAND

The constituency of Cumberland bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township fifty-four with the east boundary of the province; thence westerly along the north boundary of township fifty-four to the dividing line between ranges seven and eight west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges seven and eight to the intersection with the left bank of the Saskatchewan River; thence westerly along the left bank of the Saskatchewan River to the north limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Tobin Lake; thence westerly along the north limit of the full supply level of the reservoir known as Tobin Lake to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges eleven and twelve west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges eleven and twelve to the north boundary of township fifty-five; thence westerly along the north boundary of township fifty-five to the dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two to the north boundary of township fifty-seven; thence westerly along the north boundary of township fifty-seven to the third meridian; thence northerly along the third meridian to the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude; thence easterly along the fifty-ninth parallel of north latitude to the meridian through the one hundred and fifth degree of west longitude; thence northerly along the said meridian of longitude to the north boundary of the province; thence easterly along the north boundary of the province to the east boundary of the province; thence southerly along the east boundary of the province to the point of commencement; and adding thereto that part of the Montreal Lake Indian Reserve No. 106 lying south of the north boundary of township fifty-seven.

## CUTKNIFE-LLOYDMINSTER

The constituency of Cutknife-Lloydminster bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township forty-two with the west boundary of the province; thence easterly along the north boundary of township forty-two to the intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence north-westerly along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the west boundary of the province; thence southerly along the west boundary of the province to the point of commencement; excepting thereout and therefrom that part of the constituency hereinbefore described as The Battlefords lying south and west of the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River.

## ESTEVAN

The constituency of Estevan bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province with the dividing line between ranges twelve and thirteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twelve and thirteen to the north boundary of township six; thence easterly along the north boundary of township six to the dividing line between ranges five and six west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges five and six to the north boundary of township three; thence easterly along the north boundary of township three to the dividing line between ranges four and five west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges four and five to the south boundary of the province; thence westerly along the south boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

## HUMBOLDT

The constituency of Humboldt bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty with the third meridian; thence northerly along the third meridian to the north boundary of township thirty-eight; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-eight to the dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two to the north boundary of township thirty-three; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-three to the dividing line between ranges twenty-two and twenty-three west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-two and twenty-three to the north boundary of township twenty-nine; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-nine to the dividing line between ranges twenty-five and twenty-six west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-five and twenty-six to the north boundary of township thirty; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty to the point of commencement.

## INDIAN HEAD-WOLSELEY

The constituency of Indian Head-Wolseley bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township twelve with the dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen to the north boundary of township sixteen; thence easterly along the north boundary of township sixteen to the dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen to the north boundary of township nineteen; thence easterly along the north boundary of township nineteen to the intersection with the north-easterly bank of Lake Katepwa; thence south-easterly along the north-easterly bank of Lake Katepwa and the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River and the northerly banks of Crooked Lake and Round Lake to the east boundary of the Ochapowace Indian Reserve No. 71; thence southerly and westerly along the east and south boundaries of the Ochapowace Indian Reserve No. 71 to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges three and four west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges three and four to the north boundary of township fourteen; thence westerly along the north boundary of township fourteen to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges six and seven west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges six and seven to the north boundary of township twelve; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twelve to the point of commencement.

## KELSEY-TISDALE

The constituency of Kelsey-Tisdale bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty-nine with the east boundary of the province; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-nine to the intersection with the east boundary of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90; thence northerly and westerly and southerly along the east and north and west boundaries of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90 to the intersection with the north bank of Nut Lake; thence westerly and southerly along the north and west banks of Nut Lake to the north boundary of township thirty-eight; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-eight to the dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen to the north boundary of township forty-five; thence easterly along the north boundary of township forty-five to the dividing line between ranges seven and eight west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges seven and eight to the north boundary of township forty-eight; thence easterly along the north boundary of township forty-eight to the dividing line between ranges two and three west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges two and three to the north boundary of township fifty-two; thence easterly along the north boundary of township fifty-two to the east boundary of the province; thence southerly along the east boundary of the province to the point of commencement.

## KELVINGTON-WADENA

The constituency of Kelvington-Wadena bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township twenty-five with the dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen to the north boundary of township twenty-seven; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-seven to the dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen to the intersection with the south bank of Little Quill Lake; thence easterly along the south bank of Little Quill Lake to the dividing line between ranges fourteen and fifteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges fourteen and fifteen to the north boundary of township thirty-eight; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-eight to the intersection with the west bank of Nut Lake; thence northerly along the west bank of Nut Lake to the intersection with the west boundary of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90; thence northerly and easterly and southerly along the west and north and east boundaries of the Nut Lake Indian Reserve No. 90 to the north boundary of township thirty-nine; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-nine to the dividing line between ranges nine and ten west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges nine and ten to the north boundary of township thirty-three; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-three to the dividing line between ranges eight and nine west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges eight and nine to the north boundary of township twenty-five; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-five to the point of commencement.

## KINDERSLEY

The constituency of Kindersley bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty-three with the west boundary of the province; thence southerly along the west boundary of the province to the intersection with the left bank of the Red Deer River; thence easterly along the left bank of the Red Deer River to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence easterly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen to the north boundary of township twenty-four; thence easterly along the north boundary of township twenty-four to the dividing line between ranges seventeen and eighteen west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges seventeen and eighteen to the north boundary of township twenty-seven; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-seven to the dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen west of the third meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen to the north boundary of township thirty-three; thence westerly along the north boundary of township thirty-three to the point of commencement.

## KINISTINO

The constituency of Kinistino bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty-eight with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence easterly along the north boundary of township thirty-eight to the dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two to the north boundary of township thirty-nine; thence easterly along the said north boundary of township thirty-nine to the east boundary of section six in township forty in range twenty-one west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the east boundaries of sections six, seven and eighteen and easterly along the south boundaries of sections twenty and twenty-one and northerly along the east boundaries of sections twenty-one, twenty-eight, thirty-three and westerly along the north boundary of section thirty-three, all in township forty, in range twenty-one, west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the east boundaries of sections five, eight and seven teen and westerly along the north boundary of section seventeen and northerly along the east boundary of section nineteen and westerly along the north boundary of section nineteen, all in township forty-one, in range twenty-one, west of the second meridian, to the dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two, west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two, ranges twenty-one A and twenty-two, a nd ranges twenty-one and twenty-two respectively to the north boundary of section eighteen, in township forty-five, in range twenty-one west of the second meridian; thence easterly along the north boundaries of sections eighteen, seven teen, sixteen, fifteen, fourteen and thirteen, and southerly along the east boundary of section thirteen, all in township forty-five in range twenty-one west of the second meridian, to the north boundary of township forty-five; thence easterly along the said north boundary of township forty-five to the dividing line between ranges twenty and twenty-one west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty and twenty-one to the intersection with the left bank of the Saskatchewan River; thence north-westerly along the left bank of the Saskatchewan River to its confluence with the South Saskatchewan River; thence directly south to the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence south-westerly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the point of commencement; excepting thereout the therefrom that part of The Town of Vonda lying north of the north boundary of township thirty-eight.

## LAST MOUNTAIN-TOUCHWOOD

The constituency of Last Mountain-Touchwood bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township twenty-seven with the dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen west of the second meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-seven to the dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges fifteen and sixteen to the north boundary of township twenty-nine; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-nine to the intersection with the east boundary of the Day Star Indian Reserve No. 87; thence northerly and westerly and southerly along the east and north and west boundaries of the Day Star Indian Reserve No. 87 to the intersection with the north boundary of the Poor Man Indian Reserve No. 88; thence westerly and southerly along the north and west boundaries of the Poor Man Indian Reserve No. 88 to the intersection with the north boundary of township twenty-nine; thence westerly along the north boundary of township twenty-nine to the dividing line between ranges twenty-three and twenty-four west of the second meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-three and twenty-four to the intersection with the eastern bank of Last Mountain Lake in township twenty-eight; thence southerly and easterly along the eastern bank of Last Mountain Lake to the intersection with the left bank of Last Mountain Creek; thence easterly along the left bank of said Last Mountain Creek to the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River; thence easterly along the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River and the north banks of the Fishing Lakes to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen west of the second meridian; thence northerly along the said dividing line between ranges thirteen and fourteen to the point of commencement; excepting thereout and therefrom any portion of the Town of Fort Qu'Appelle which may lie to the north of the left bank of the Qu'Appelle River; and adding thereto any part of the area comprised within The Village of Craven lying south of the left bank of Last Mountain Creek and the left bank of the Qu Appelle River.

## MAPLE CREEK

The constituency of Maple Creek bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township six with the west boundary of the province; thence northerly along the west boundary of the province to the intersection with the left bank of the Red Deer River; thence easterly along the left bank of the Red Deer River to the intersection with the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River; thence easterly along the left bank of the South Saskatchewan River to the intersection with the dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges eighteen and nineteen to the north boundary of township nine; thence westerly along the north boundary of township nine to the dividing line between ranges twenty-four and twenty-five west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the said dividing line between ranges twenty-four and twenty-five to the north boundary of township six; thence westerly along the north boundary of township six to the point of commencement.

## MEADOW LAKE

The constituency of Yorkton comprising the area described as follows: All of townships twenty-five and twenty-six in range three west of the second meridian; all of townships twenty-five and twenty-six in range four west of the second meridian; and all of townships twenty-five and twenty-six in range five west of the second meridian.
